MUSIC TEACHING ASSISTANT INTERNSHIP

Artz for the Harp is a nonprofit arts organization that provides harps and harp classes, lessons and camps to students throughout the Atlanta area. We also seek to better communities who need us most, through the use of music instruction as a positive artistic outlet. Our goal is to provide instruction to students in after school programs, community centers, hospitals and camps throughout the year. During lessons our focus is on developing basic music theory skills as well as the fundamentals of the harp through practice and performance.

Skills taught through AFTH, but not limited to:

Basic Music Theory

Harp History and Evolvement

Harp Position, posture, and techniques

Songwriting/Composition

Solo/ Group Ensemble Work

Interns will not be responsible for teaching harp, only assisting in group instruction, classroom management, teaching basic music theory and reinforcement of skills taught as well as light administrative work. Interns must also attend all recitals/concerts during internship.

Timeframes

Fall/ Winter Semester: 10 to 15 hours per week during fall/winter semester

Summer Semester: 20 hours per week

This music internship is most beneficial to music majors. However, some music minors may qualify if they have previous musical training/experience. This is also the perfect internship, for students interested in becoming a part of the nonprofit world.

This music internship will allow students to gain real world experience in basic music instruction with students from 5 to 17 years of age. Students will also become familiar with all the moving parts of a nonprofit organization, from fundraising, to board meeting information, strategic planning and grant writing do's and don'ts.

Further Responsibilities of a Music Teaching Assistant:

- 1. Guide students in improving their musical skills
- 2. Assist in classroom instruction
- 3. Grading short musical exercises
- 4. Informal observation of students to assist them with needs
- 5. Encourage students and give students positive constructive feedback
- 6. Assist with planning of mini recitals/concerts
- 7. Set up and Breakdown of classrooms
- 8. Assist in providing a safe, secure, nurturing environment for instruction
- 9. Assisting with collection of pertinent forms, light admin work
- 10. Have fun!

Requirements

Student must be in good academic standing, no less than a 2.5 GPA.

Student must be at least a sophomore at attending school

Student must successfully pass a background check.

Student must have reliable transportation to get to and from worksites on time.

Student must attend intern/volunteer training

Student must attend and assist with recitals/concerts.

Intern Schedule: flexible and will be arranged to meet the current needs of AFTH and Intern.
