West India Lock Opening Times

Friday 23rd August - lock opens 1430 closes 1500

Sat 24th August. - lock opens 0930 closes 1000.

Monday 26 Aug – lock opens 1430 closes 1500 hrs

Call West India Lock control Ch13 for permission and instructions (if you are with a group one call advising of numbers will suffice)

ATYC Rally Locks. The afternoon lock on Saturday and the early morning lock on Monday have been cancelled due to no demand. All other lock-ins are as advertised.

Calor Gas Cylinders – Latest. Calor has confirmed that it has ordered "a significant number" of new 3.9kg propane and 4.5kg butane cylinders, which will be available via Calor Distribution Centres and retail partners in the coming weeks. For years, boaters have struggled to source 4.5kg cylinders in the UK. Initially, Calor blamed high seasonal demand and a shortage of workers due to the COVID-19 pandemic for the problem. Then in January 2023, the firm announced it would discontinue its 4.5kg butane cylinders and 3.9kg propane cylinders, along with the Cube, 6Lite Propane and 12kg Butane cylinders. Calor reversed its decision on the 4.5kg butane cylinders and 3.9kg propane cylinders in December 2023 following an outcry from the boating community, with many boat owners stating that gas lockers on older boats would only take 4.5kg bottles or smaller.

Morco Water Heater Alert. This relates to a safety alert issued by Morco Products Ltd for their open flued LPG water heaters. There may be potentially dangerous models of these LPG water heaters that may leak gas causing fires or explosions. Morco's concerns are that appliance test-point screws may not have been correctly tightened at the time of commissioning or servicing. This issue may potentially lead to un-rectified water heaters leaking unburnt gas with the risk of fires or explosions with possible resulting burns and injuries. The Boat Safety Scheme (BSS) is working with Morco to support them to find and fix these potentially dangerous models. The BSS has created a webpage and briefing for boat owners https://www.boatsafetyscheme.org/stay-safe-advice/known-recalls-safety-alerts/ where you can get more information. Morco is also offering free upgrades for the affected models.
