**RALLY RALLY** Do you want to be part of the largest boat rally taking place on the Thames this year? - then join your club and other River Thames Yacht Clubs at this year's Association of Thames Yacht Clubs (ATYC) Rally.

This year's rally is being held in the heart of London's Docklands, spending the weekend in the iconic West India and Millwall Docks over the August Bank Holiday. During the weekend there will be the opportunity to participate in a drinks reception, evening buffet style dinner, disco and breakfast the following morning in the Britannia International Hotel adjacent to the dockside. There will also be a boat handling demonstration and plenty of time to meet friends, old and new, from other clubs up and down the length of the river Thames. As with other tidal cruises, boats from each club will likely travel together, in one or more groups depending on numbers. Clubs will moor as groups in specified mooring areas.

**EA Navigation Charges Consultation** The consultation is now live. Some of the tables and numbers relating to the Dutch Barges are incorrect but due to the usual Election embargo the EA will not amend or republish the correct figures

**French Check in/out** French officials have announced a new 'protocol' for small boats to enter France from outside of the European Union (EU). Normally boats would have to arrive at and depart from a Port of Entry (PPF), although last year there were a few ports with a special derogation which allowed entry for a limited period.

The new 'protocol', which came into force on 1 June, grants some 53 marinas (which are not PPFs) the rights to handle boats arriving from or departing to <u>outside of the EU/Schengen area</u>. Skippers of these boats will need to email a specific completed form to the relevant port in advance of arrival or departure.
