Scholarship Opportunities

It's most important that responses are detailed and complete to help the Scholarship Committee better know the applicant. - 3. After reviewing all applications, the Scholarship Committee will contact all applicants by mail.
- 4. This application is for one academic school year. However, a student may reapply in following years, if qualifications are met.
