## Driving Directions

### From Rocky Mount West

Get on US-64 West from Atlantic Avenue. Continue on US-64 West. Take I-87 and I-40 West to US-64 West in Cary. Take Exit 98B from US-1 S/US-64 West. Follow US-64 West to Country Club Drive in Matthews.

### From Oxford South

Get on I-85 South. Continue to Durham. Follow US-15 South/US-501 South and US-64 West to Country Club Drive in Matthews.

### From Winston-Salem East

Get on I-40 East. Take Exit 212A on the left to merge onto US-421 South toward I-73 South/I-85. Continue on I-73-South. Continue on US-421 South toward I-85 North/I-40 East. Take Exit 126 to merge onto US-421 South toward Sanford. Take Exit 174 onto Piney Grove Church Road. Left onto Old Highway 421. Right onto East Raleigh Street. Left onto Country Club Drive.

### From Charlotte North

Get on I-85 North. Take Exit 96 on US-64 toward Asheboro. Turn right onto West Third Street. Turn right onto North Fir Street. Right onto West Raleigh Street. Left onto Country Club Drive.
