

Free Emergency Healthcare for Veterans

Veterans in mental health crisis can go to any VA facility for emergency health care at no cost – including inpatient care for 30 days and outpatient care for up to 90 days.

Veterans do not need to be enrolled in the VA system to use this benefit.
