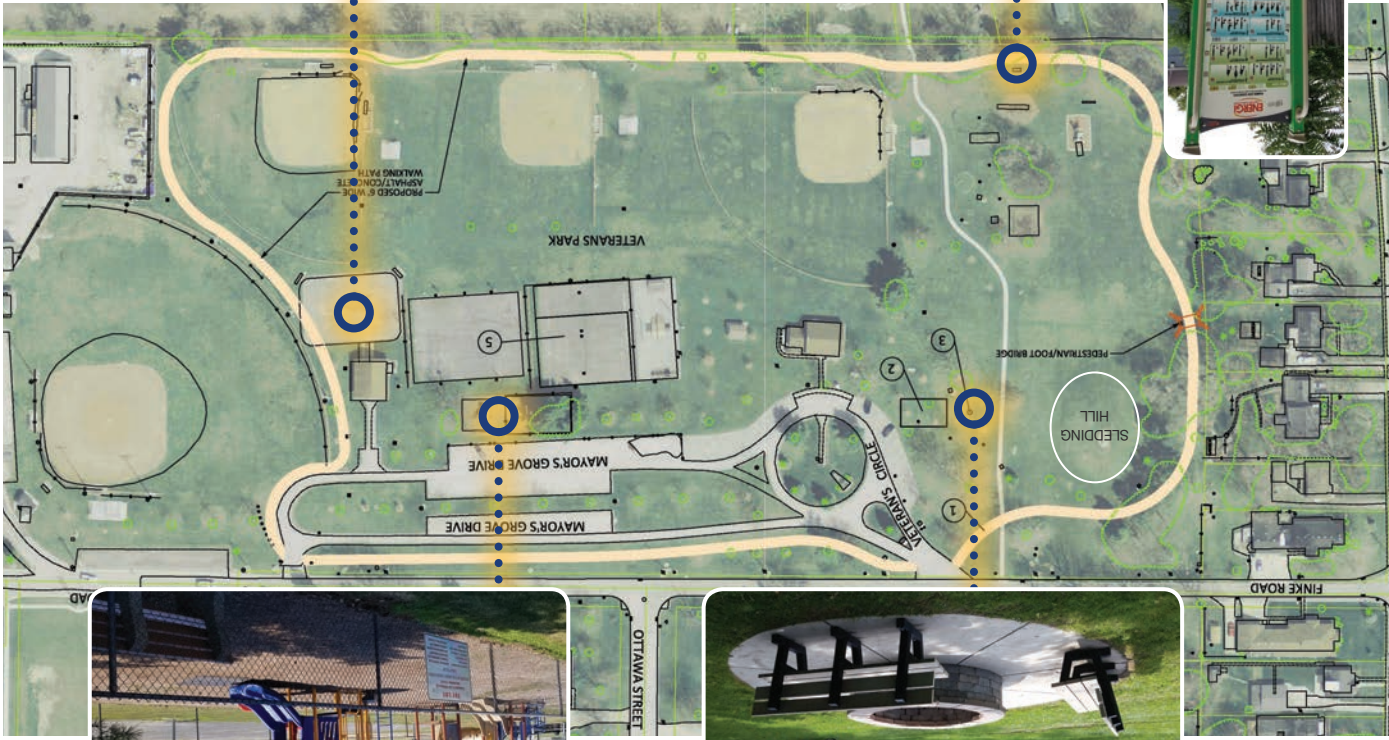




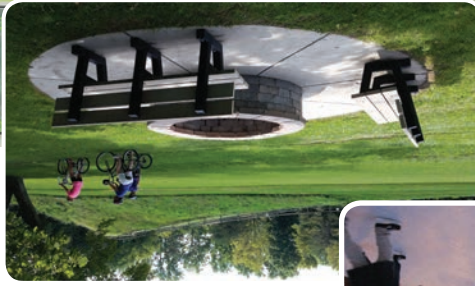

- Established in 2012 to advance the concepts defined in the Village of Oak Harbor Downtown Revitalization Plan (March 2012), the Oak Harbor Development Group continues to identify future improvements to afford residents and visitors an enhanced quality of life. The Group has developed a master plan for future improvements on the Riverfront, in Veterans Park, and pedestrian/bicycling paths connecting public places. It will take time, talent and treasure to implement the master plan. The Development Group has established a Founders Program for fundraising efforts. The Founders Program identifies how businesses and individuals can be actively involved in the construction of the improvements "one idea at a time".

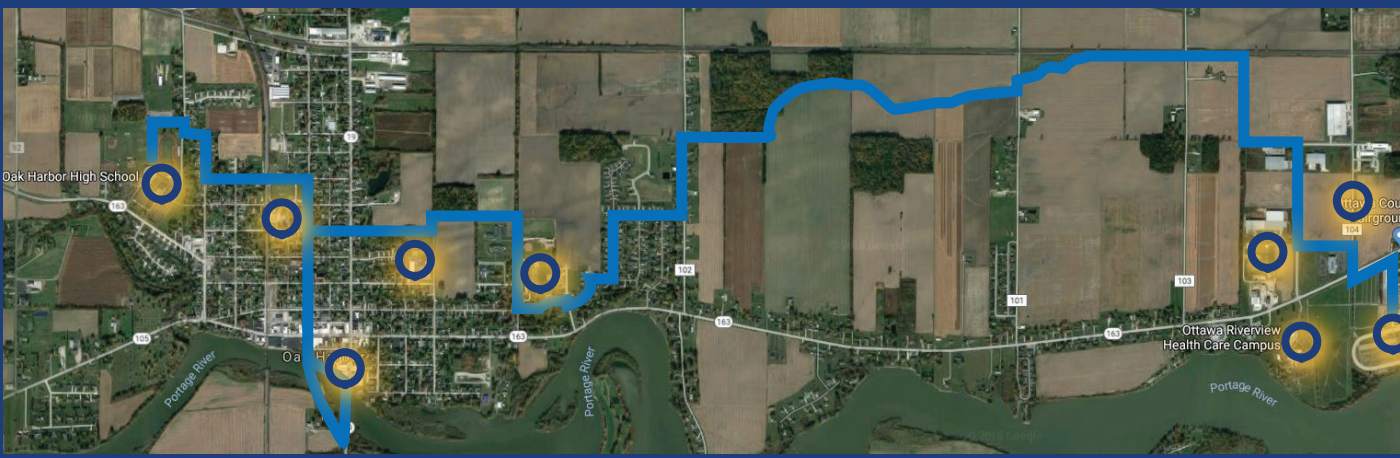
