Devotional Reading:

Hebrews 11:1-2 *“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”*

Scripture Focus: Faith as the Key to Miracles

- **Hebrews 11:1-6:** The foundation of faith and examples of those who experienced wonders through faith.
- **Matthew 9:20-22:** The woman with the issue of blood – a testimony of faith bringing healing.
- **John 11:38-44:** The raising of Lazarus – faith in God’s timing and power.

Discussion Questions:

- How does faith activate miracles, signs, and wonders?
- What is the relationship between faith and God’s will?
- Can miracles happen without faith? Why or why not?

The Wonders of Faith in Action

- Biblical examples of faith unlocking miracles:
 - Noah: Building the ark in faith (Genesis 6:13-22).
 - The Centurion’s faith: Trusting Jesus’ word alone (Matthew 8:5-13).

Interactive Activity: A Step of Faith

- **Exercise:** Write down a “faith challenge” or a situation where you need God to show His wonders.
- **Pray** for one another’s faith and the manifestation of God’s signs and miracles.

Faith Applied to Daily Life

Faith-Filled Actions:

- Faith is not passive; it requires action (James 2:17).

- Examples: Stepping out in obedience, taking risks for God, or trusting Him despite challenges.

Faith and the Church Theme:

- Connecting faith with Miracles, Signs, and Wonders.
- Faith positions us to witness God's power in extraordinary ways.

Discussion Questions:

- How can you build your faith daily?
- How can we, as a church, create an atmosphere of faith that welcomes miracles, signs, and wonders?

Closing Prayer and Commitment

- **Reflection:** Share one insight or takeaway from the class.
- **Prayer Focus:** Ask God to increase faith and release miracles, signs, and wonders in personal lives and the church community.
- **Commitment:** Encourage participants to step out in faith during the week ahead.

Faith and the Church Theme

- **Faith's Role in Miracles:** Faith is the key that opens the door to God's supernatural power.
- **God's Promise:** Miracles, signs, and wonders follow those who believe (Mark 16:17).

Scriptures to Meditate On:

- Hebrews 11:1-6 – Faith defined and exemplified.
- Matthew 17:20 – Faith moves mountains.
- John 14:12-14 – Faith in Jesus brings greater works.

Action Steps for Faith:

- Trust God even when circumstances seem impossible.
- Act in faith, believing in God's power to perform wonders.
- Pray bold prayers, expecting miracles.

Reflection Questions:

- Where in your life do you need a miracle?
- What actions of faith can you take this week to trust God more deeply?
