Scripture Text

- Exodus 14:13–31; Psalm 77:14

Lesson Focus

- To understand that miracles are God's supernatural interventions, revealing His glory and His ability to make a way when there seems to be none.

Key Teaching Points

- God works beyond natural limits to bring deliverance.
- Miracles in Scripture remind us that nothing is too hard for God.
- Miracles strengthen faith and inspire trust in God's promises.

Discussion Questions

- What miracles in your life remind you that God is still active today?
- How can remembering past miracles help us in present struggles?

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November 12, 2025

"Signs That Point to God"

Scripture Text

- John 2:1–11; John 20:30–31

Lesson Focus

- To explore how signs serve as divine markers that point us toward God's character, presence, and purposes.

Key Teaching Points

- Signs are not the end in themselves; they point us to the Savior.
- Signs confirm God's Word and His identity as Creator and Redeemer.
- Our faith should rest not in the sign, but in the God behind the sign.

Discussion Questions

- Why do you think Jesus performed signs and wonders during His ministry?
- How can we avoid chasing signs instead of seeking the God of signs?

Scripture Text

- Acts 2:43; Habakkuk 1:5

Lesson Focus

- To recognize how God’s wonders stir awe and reverence, drawing people closer to Him in worship and obedience..

Key Teaching Points

- Wonders cause us to acknowledge God’s greatness and majesty.
- They remind us that His ways are higher than our ways.
- Wonders create opportunities for witness and evangelism.

Discussion Questions

- How do wonders differ from miracles and signs?
- Share a time when you were in awe of God’s work in your life or community.

“Living in God’s Power Today”

Scripture Text

- Mark 16:17–20; Ephesians 3:20–21

Lesson Focus

- To embrace that the same power that worked through Jesus and the apostles is alive in believers today to transform lives and expand God’s kingdom.

Key Teaching Points

- The Holy Spirit empowers believers to be vessels of God’s supernatural power.
- Signs and wonders confirm the preaching of the Gospel.
- God’s power works through us in everyday life, not just extraordinary moments.

Discussion Questions

- How can we position ourselves to experience God’s power in daily living?
- In what ways can the church today demonstrate God’s power to a watching world?
