Scripture Focus

- Job 22:28 (NIV) "What you decide on will be done, and light will shine on your ways."
- Isaiah 55:10-11 (NIV) "As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and
 do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish...
 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but
 will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Introduction

The Creative Power of God's Word on Our Lips

- God's Word brings life, order, and power when spoken in faith.
- The same Word that created the universe is now in our mouths.

Reflection Prompt

How have you seen the Word of God reshape a situation when spoken aloud?

Understanding the Will of God to Confidently Declare It

- We can only decree what God backs up. That means knowing His will.
- The more we study His Word, the more we can declare with confidence.

Reflection Prompt

What helps you discern God's will more clearly in daily life?

Aligning Our Declarations with Scripture

- Speak what God says, not just what you feel.
- Biblical declarations keep our emotions and thoughts in check with truth.

- Examples:
 - "I am more than a conqueror." (Romans 8:37)
 - "No weapon formed against me shall prosper." (Isaiah 54:17)
 - "My God shall supply all my needs." (Philippians 4:19)

Practical Exercise: Your Miracle Confession

- Instructions:
 - Think of one miracle you are believing God for. Then create a faith confession to speak over it daily. Use scripture to anchor your declaration.
- Example:

Now You Try:

- Miracle: Restoration in my family
- Confession: "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. God is the restorer of broken places and the healer of families. Unity and peace live in my home." (Joshua 24:15, Isaiah 58:12, Psalm 133:1)
