

TRAINING & SAFETY TIPS BEFORE HUNTING

TRAIN BEFORE YOU TAKE YOUR DOG ON A HUNT

Hunting with your Boykin Spaniel is absolutely the best sporting experience you and your dog can have. It warms the heart and brings a smile to your face to see your Boykin Spaniel in the element they are meant to be in. Hunting is an enjoyable time, although safety should be your first priority.

When on a hunting trip, there is always a need for safety for you and your Boykin and any fellow hunters in the field. First, your Boykin Spaniel needs to have obedience before attempting a hunting trip. This can occur through you training them or training with the help of a professional (group or private sessions). If you choose to go with a professional make sure they have experience with Boykin Spaniels. Personal recommendation is that you should definitely be involved in the training in some capacity. Afterall, it is you that will be going out hunting with your dog. Boykins are fairly easy to train because of their eagerness to please and eagerness for attention. Of course, this takes time, patience and dedication. It is always best to start training at an early age in very small timespans, frequently, due to level of attention. Start at a young age retrieving bumpers, bumpers with wings and bird bumpers; short distances at first and build up and eventually run retrieving drills (there are plenty of helpful books on obedience & gundog training). Variety is the name of the game! Make sure your dog is gunshot acclimated by starting at a far distance away (100 yards) from the dog while playing a game he loves (usually retrieving). Then slowly move closer to the dog. This works best with two people, one observing the dog while retrieving and the other with the shot and communicating with each other. Always, reward your dog with positive reinforcement when they are doing what you want during a training session.


YOUR FIRST HUNT OR HUNT PRACTICE

Don't make your first hunt with your dog with a large group of hunters and other dogs. It probably won't go well. Introduce your dog to birds and shooting slowly. You and one friend and you focus on your dog while your buddy shoots. If you have access, it is best to first work in a field area with a few release-birds. Gradually work up to larger hunts.

SAFETY HUNTS TIPS

Always review the fundamental gun safety rules just to refresh yourself before your trip and make sure all your hunting buddies are on the same page of gun safety for you and your dog's sake. You should always wear ear and eye protection when hunting. It is best to be safe than sorry.

Proper hunting supplies are a must for you and your dog. Safety blaze orange vest for your dog is important for you and other hunters to visually see your dog in the field. It also helps with protecting the underside of their body from brush, thorns and stickers in the field. If hunting upland, you of course must have blaze orange on also. When hunting waterfowl, a buoyant vest for your dog may be helpful and proper gear for you as well to keep warm & dry. It is very important to have a first-aid kit, please refer to the BSCBAA slide presentation at our [health & genetics website page](#), presented by Dr. Bill Howard on [First-aid kits for dogs](#). While you are there on our [health page](#), see recommendations from [Bill on Ear Care](#).



You should plan to bring plenty of food, treats, probiotics, supplements and water for hydration in the field and at the campsite. Also, don't forget the dog shampoo, towels, ear cleaner and special comb for those ears to get the knots and stickers out. This will make the ride home more pleasant and comfortable for everyone. If in real cold weather, or hunting in tough brush and fields you may want to bring some *Mushers Secret* for paw protection or *Tuf-Foot* to aid in protecting paws. Hunting gear & supplies can be found at most outfitters online like gundogsupply.com or dogsunlimited.com or stores that are hunting friendly.

Please contact Bill Howard, DVM and chair of the BSCBAA Health and Genetics committee at contact@theboykinspanielclub.com for any questions. The following are the requirements for a Boykin Spaniel to obtain OFA certification per the BSCBAA:

1. Eye Examination by a boarded ACVO Ophthalmologist with results registered with OFA or CERF.
2. Patellar Luxation - OFA Evaluation
3. Hip Dysplasia - OFA or OVC or PennHip Evaluation
4. Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC)
5. Collie Eye Anomaly (CEA)
6. Degenerative Myelopathy (DM)

Optional:

1. Congenital Cardiac Database
2. Elbow Dysplasia

BSCBAA TAIL DOCKING FORMULA & PROCEDURE

Established in 2013 by BSCBAA

Leave 1/3 of the tail plus 1/4 inch; please use a ruler. Dock tail between 3-5 days of age—3 days is preferred. There is consistently a natural indentation where the tail should be docked. If the measurement falls between joints, look and feel for the one where there is a natural indentation. REMEMBERING—Longer is preferred. Best practices done by vet with breeder attending & overseeing.
