The BSCBAA Board of Directors and Officers established the 2026 BSCBAA Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee was established with Ginger Hurley, as chair, Daniel Swanter as SW member, Dawn Fields, as SE member and two alternates Stacy Fox, SE and Campbell Faulkner, SW. The committee was formed for the nomination of Class of 2029 candidates for the Board of Director vacancies created by outgoing BSCBAA Class of 2026 Board. The BOD Members Class of 2026 are Cassandra Jacobsen, Mike McMahon, Tim Pullian, Carl Schwenker, and Kathleen Yeaman. Thank you outgoing board members - we appreciate your service to the club.

The BSCBAA Board of Directors is pleased to present this diverse group of talented & mostly new Board Nominees for the Class of 2029:
Katie Eaton, TX; Campbell Faulkner, TX; Shannon Lambert, SC; Sue McMahon, TX; Mariah Swinker, MO.

Katie Eaton: Katie & husband, Gary have four children (3 girls and 1 boy). Katie has been involved in working, showing and competition canines since 1999. Katie and her husband own and operate a specialty security company (Detection Services). Detection Services has provided specialty security services to the energy industry to include detection K-9s for the last 20 years. Detection Services currently deploys Boykin Spaniels, Belgian Malinois and German Shepherds along with their handlers to various locations across the country weekly. Katie has been breeding, working with dogs and exhibiting in show dogs for over twenty years(Boykins for eight of those). Katie has bred multiple show champions (including Sporting group winning dogs) and multiple dogs with hunting titles and other performance titles. Katie has been involved in the BSCBAA club for approximately eight years, has been on the National Specialty committee and is also helping with Judges education.

Campbell Faulkner: Campbell is the Senior Vice President, Chief Data Analyst at OTC Global Holdings, LP (OTCGH). He has more than 10 years of technical, operational, and sales experience and leads the market data team in addition to all quantitative development efforts. He is a graduate of Creighton University and studied quantitative modeling and methodologies during his Political Science education. In his free time, he enjoys upland and waterfowl hunting with his Boykin Spaniel Lucy. He has also served as event photographer for the Texas BSCBAA events and most recently at the 2025 National Specialty Hunt Test. He brings many skills to the Board with financial background, operational management, market data development, and technical skills that will be an asset to the BSCBAA Board.

Shannon Lambert: Shannon serves as the operational manager for the Institute for Engaged Aging at Clemson University. She also serves as an adjunct professor in the counseling psychology department at Southern Wesleyan University. In accordance with the Bylaws, additional nominations of the eligible members may be made by written petition signed by five members, addressed to the BSCBAA Secretary, and received at the BSCBAA's Post Office Box 502, Hempstead, TX 77445 on or before 30 days after membership notification of the slate of Directors has been sent (11/29/25). If there are no valid additional nominees received by the secretary on or before 30 days after the sent date of the notification, the nominating committee's slate shall be declared elected at the time of Annual Meeting and no further balloting will be required. 



HEALTH AND GENETICS Please contact Bill Howard, DVM and chair of the BSCBAA Health and Genetics committee at contact@theboykinspanielclub.com for any questions. The following are the requirements for a Boykin Spaniel to obtain OFA certification per the BSCBAA:

1. Eye Examination by a boarded ACVO Ophthalmologist with results registered with OFA or CERF.
2. Patellar Luxation - OFA Evaluation
3. Hip Dysplasia - OFA or OVC or PennHip Evaluation
4. Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC)
5. Collie Eye Anomaly (CEA)
6. Degenerative Myelopathy (DM)

Optional:

- Congenital Cardiac Database
- Elbow Dysplasia

BSCBAA TAIL DOCKING FORMULA & PROCEDURES

Established in 2013 by BSCBAA

Leave 1/3 of the tail plus 1/4 inch; please use a ruler. Dock tail between 3-5 days of age—3 days is preferred. There is consistently a natural indentation where the tail should be docked. If the measurement falls between joints, look and feel for the one where there is a natural indentation. REMEMBERING—Longer is preferred. Best practices done by vet with breeder attending & overseeing.
