
















COVEY AND ANGEL PAWS: THERAPY MINISTRY

Covey, the best boy ever, is a Therapy Dog participating in our church pet therapy ministry, Angel Paws. Our director knew the impact dogs can have in lowering stress and bringing comfort, so she presented the ministry opportunity to the church. In 2019, Covey joined in the third class of dogs and he is now the oldest dog in the program at 11 years old.

Covey and I get to visit people of all ages and stages. He excels in his memory care visits. We have made friends, and he has a fan club at our assisted living center. One friend was at the center in memory care for several months before we met her. She was having a difficult time adjusting to the change and was confused. At the end of a visit from her husband, Covey and I arrived. When she saw him, she wheeled herself over and gave him the biggest hug. Covey leaned into her too. She had tears in her eyes and shared with me that she just gets overwhelmed when she comes out of her room with all the people who don't have regular family visits, so she isolates to pray. That is exactly why we visit. I have been able to pray with her regularly and she looks forward to our visits. After that first visit, she started joining the group activities more and now she is out every time we come. She told me she loves Covey because, "I looked into his eyes and he stole my heart."

On July 4, 2025 devastating flash floods tore through the Texas Hill Country. Living in Houston my whole life, I know the impact of natural disaster. Our team knew we needed to mobilize because we had something unique and meaningful to share. Five days after the flood, we loaded up 4 dogs and six adults in a van with no plan and drove the four hours to Kerrville. On the way, one member received a reply from a social media post from a local reporter who was on the ground in Kerrville. He wanted to meet us and interview us for the 6:00 news that evening. He gave us locations we needed to visit to bring comfort. We know that God used that social media post to guide our visits throughout the day. We left without a plan, and God directed our steps.

During that visit, we visited a church that was acting as a home base for first responders, feeding them meals and offering showers and a place to park. We met responders from all over the state and country. Covey brought the joy and hugs they needed as they were facing the unimaginable. They had no idea what they would find each time they went into the field, and some had no idea how long they would be deployed. We prayed with many. One encounter will stay with me forever. The story became personal, even though I never knew them. A local first responder approached me with something in his hand and a face full of emotion. He asked, "Can I ask something of you?" I told him I would help in any way I could. He then handed me a bone shaped tag from a dog collar with the name "Tucker" on it. On the back were Tucker's owner's phone numbers. He informed me that he had found Tucker's remains and had taken the tag to make a notification. He said, "Because you are a pet therapy ministry, maybe you can deliver the news better than I can." How could I refuse?







I think deep down, he suspected Tucker's family may not have survived the flood and his heart couldn't take it. I proceeded to call the first number on the tag and got voicemail, but the owner gave her name in that message. I left her a message informing her that Tucker did not survive and that the first responder respectfully and lovingly took care of him. But even then, I had a sinking feeling in the pit of my stomach, so I searched the list of missing people from the flood. Sadly, I found Tucker's owners were still missing. I then saw a social media post from a family member seeking information about them, so I messaged her after I returned home. Theirs is a story of hope and survival. While Tucker and his owners did not survive the flood, three family members were rescued and were being treated at the hospital. I was able to return Tucker's tag to her. She said that Tucker was a spoiled and beloved pet.

Since that first trip to Kerrville, we have been back two additional times. I reached out to the schools in Kerrville asking if we could bring the dogs for a visit in some capacity. They asked us to come on the first day of teacher in-service to visit each campus and bring comfort and love to the teachers as they are facing a difficult year ahead. It was a packed day visiting 6 schools and loving on teachers and staff. We started our day at the alternative high school. One teacher in particular had walls up. She said she had dogs at home and didn't need to pet ours. No problem. But there's something about Covey. I have always described him as "lovingly assertive." He very slowly creeps into your space and heart. As I was talking to the teacher next to the "closed" teacher, Covey made his move. Slowly and gently, he pulled the lead into the personal space of the walled off teacher. She finally said, "Ok, fine, I will pet you." SUCCESS! Covey leaned in as she hugged him. We started talking about how she had been serving in the community after the flood and the students present and past who lost family. I asked her if I could pray with her and she agreed. She had tears in her eyes after the prayer. Covey did his job well. He knows his job and excels at it.


On our school tour, we spent an extended lunch at the larger high school. This was an intentionally longer visit. The soccer coach, his wife and their two children all lost their lives in the flood. That afternoon, the staff was getting on buses to go to the memorial service for the family. This visit was full of joy, but also tears and much prayer. As we were leaving, the school choir was loading buses to go sing at the memorial service. Covey walked into the crowd and got a lot of hugs from students.

We are blessed and honored to have Covey and to be able to share him with others. Boykins really can do if all!

Sunday, March 1: A Historic First




HEALTH AND GENETICS Please contact Bill Howard, DVM and chair of the BSCBAA Health and Genetics committee at contact@theboykinspanielclub.com for any questions. The following are the requirements for a Boykin Spaniel to obtain OFA certification per the BSCBAA:

- I. Eye Examination by a boarded ACVO Ophthalmologist with results registered with OFA or CERF.
- 2. Patellar Luxation OFA Evaluation
- 3. Hip Dysplasia OFA or OVC or PennHip Evaluation
- 4. Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC)
- 5. Collie Eye Anomaly (CEA)
- 6. Degenerative Myelopathy (DM)

Optional:

Congenital Cardiac Database

Elbow Dysplasia



BSCBAA TAIL DOCKING FORMULA & PROCEDURES

Established in 2013 by BSCBAA

Leave 1/3 of the tail plus 1/4 inch; please use a ruler. Dock tail between 3-5 days of age—3 days is preferred. There is consistently a natural indentation where the tail should be docked. If the measurement falls between joints, look and feel for the one where there is a natural indentation. REMEMBERING—Longer is preferred. Best practices done by vet with breeder attending & overseeing.
