Weather Protection: Please dress your child according to the changing weather: As the temperatures continue to drop, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. Warm coats, hats, mitts and layered clothing are highly recommended. We will continue to go outside for outdoor play time as long as the weather permits, so proper outdoor attire is essential.

Health: As the fall weather brings in sniffles and throat infections, please keep your child at home if he/she displays any signs of runny nose, sore throat, cough or fever. Please keep him/her at home until the child is symptom free for 24 hours. Your cooperation in this regard is very much appreciated.

Children's Book Author visit: November 27th

We will have a presentation from children's book author Anitha Robinson. There will be a narration of her story "**A Family For Faru**", it will include some animal related warm up movements and a fun craft around Rhinos.

Our Book of November theme: is "Because Of An Acorn" by Lola M. Schaefer and Adam Schaefer. It is an enchanting book which effortlessly illustrates the vital connections between the layers of our ecosystem. It describes the forest path as to how every tree flower; plant and animal is connected together. Children will learn about a tree life cycle, the connection of the birds with the trees, the connection of human beings to the trees will be discussed in the group times, children will also learn how the seed travels to become a source of joy for all the living things around
