What is a Mixing Valve



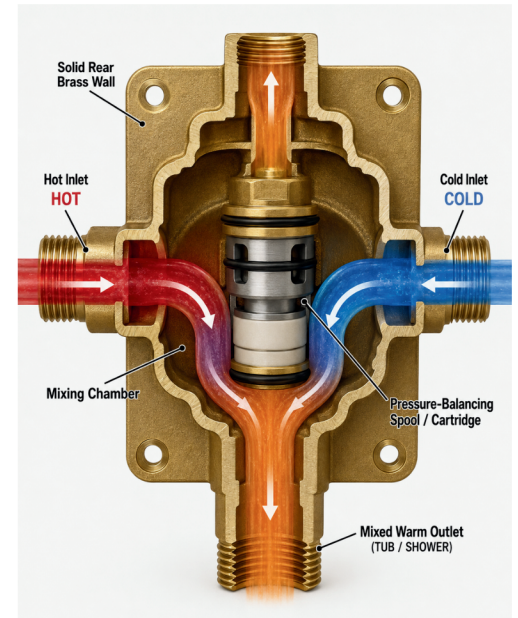
Have you ever wondered how hot and cold water come together to give you a comfortable temperature at a faucet or shower?

A **mixing valve** blends hot and cold water to deliver water at a desired temperature.

Depending on the application, mixing valves may be used at faucets, showers, tubs, or other fixtures to help provide more consistent and comfortable water temperatures.

Some mixing valves also include features designed to help manage changes in water pressure or temperature.
