# Jolly Ol' Saint Nick

The figure of SANTA CLAUS, as we know him today, is the result of centuries of traditions, folklore, and cultural blending. His story begins long before the red-suited, jolly man we see in malls and on CHRISTMAS cards. One of the earliest influences on Santa Claus was SAINT NICHOLAS, a CHRISTIAN BISHOP from the 4th century who lived in what is now TURKEY. Saint Nicholas was known for his kindness and generosity, particularly toward children. He would secretly give gifts to those in need and his acts of charity eventually led to the tradition of gift-giving at Christmas.

The DUTCH played a significant role in shaping the modern image of Santa Claus. In the 18th century, Dutch settlers in NEW YORK brought with them the tradition of celebrating "SINTERKLAAS," a holiday honoring Saint Nicholas. Sinterklaas was depicted as an elderly man with a long beard, wearing a red robe and a MITRE (pronounced my-tur), a ceremonial hat. On the evening of December 5th, children would put out their shoes, hoping that Sinterklaas would fill them with treats. This tradition eventually evolved into the Santa Claus figure, with his gift-giving customs taking root in AMERICA.

In the 19th century, American writers and artists began to further shape the image of Santa Claus. One of the most important contributions came from the poem "A VISIT FROM ST NICHOLAS" commonly known as "THE NIGHT BEFORE CHRISTMAS" written by CLEMENT CLARKE MOORE in 1823. The poem describes Santa Claus as a plump, jolly man with a sleigh pulled by reindeer, who visits children on Christmas Eve. This description solidified Santa's image as a cheerful, magical figure who brings joy and gifts to families. The poem also introduced the famous line, "He was chubby and plump, a right jolly old elf!"

In the early 20th century, Santa Claus's image was further popularized by the COCA COLA company. In 1931, the company hired artist HADDON SUNDBLOM to create a series of holiday advertisements featuring Santa. Sundblom's depiction of Santa as a warm, friendly, and plump man with a red suit, black boots, and a white beard became iconic. Coca-Cola's advertisements played a huge role in solidifying the modern image of Santa Claus that we recognize today. These images of Santa were widely

circulated, especially during the Christmas season, and helped establish the jolly, bearded man as a central figure in holiday celebrations.

While the American version of Santa Claus is most widely known, many other cultures have their own versions of the gift-bringer. In some countries, Santa is known by different names, such as PERE NOEL in FRANCE, FATHER CHRISTMAS in the UK, and WEIHNACHTSMANN in GERMANY. In some parts of the world, Santa's helpers are just as important as the man himself. For example, in Italy, LA BEFANA, a kindly witch, brings gifts to children on January 6th, while in Spain, children receive gifts from the "Three Kings." Despite these differences, the spirit of giving and the joy of the holiday season are universal themes.
