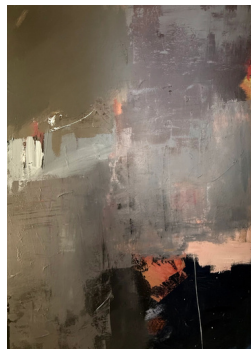
Vince Skelly, Held in a Place at Boon

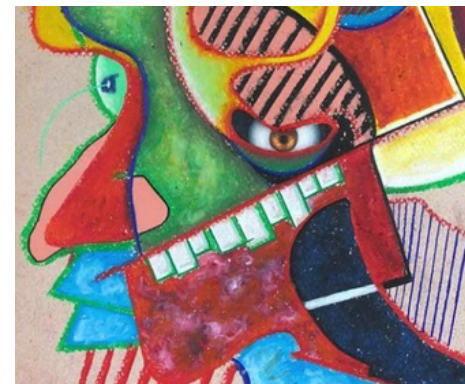

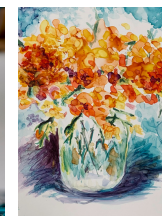

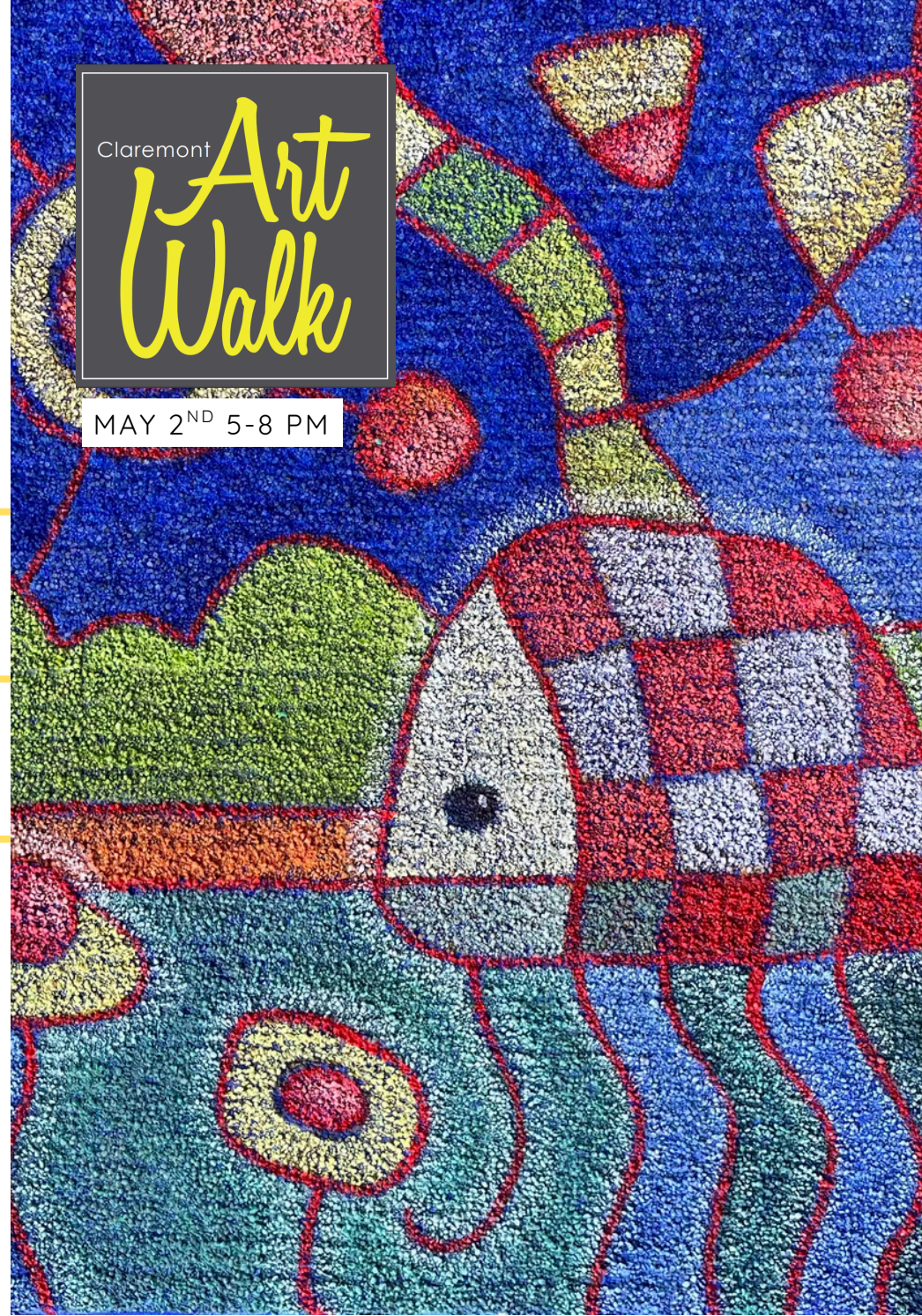
