



The **Broom Tree Fellows Program** assists ministry workers, primarily in northern Virginia, with education-related debt. The program is especially interested in religious leaders who exhibit the highest levels of faith, commitment, and service to God. Over the past ten years, the program has provided over **340 loan forgiveness awards—exceeding \$680,000—to ministry workers** dedicated to expanding Christ’s reach. These Christian ministers represent **15 denominations from dozens of churches and religious organizations**. It is our hope that in lightening the load of their education-related debts, ministry workers are able to flourish in their ministry.
