

Silverridge Golf League Scramble rules
Ken McDonald Golf Course
March 12, 2026

1.

All players will tee off from the Red Tees. Choose the ball you want to play. All 4 players will play from within one (1) club length from the point where the ball lies. Continue this procedure from tee to green. The one (1) club length rule does not apply on the green. You cannot move from rough to fairway or out of a sand trap.

2.

All putts must be holed. No “gimmies” allowed.

3.

Each player’s tee shot must be used a minimum of 2 times. No player’s tee shot will be used more than 7 times.

4.

The first player listed on the scorecard is the Captain of the team and is responsible for the accuracy of the scorecard. Please turn in the scorecard to the Coordinator at lot 633 as soon as you return to the park.

5.

Tie Breakers will be determined by scores on the most difficult holes (9, 15, 16 & 4) in that order.

6.

Closest to the pin contests on holes 8 and 11. Only the person making the shot will be paid. An additional 2 dollar fee from the scramble fee must be paid to enter the closest to the pin contest.

7.

There will be payouts for the first, second and third place teams, as well as KP. The cost will remain \$ 5.00 dollars for the scramble and \$ 2.00 for KP.

Slow play issues:

Strick ready golf (drop partner off at his/her ball, and proceed to your ball).

Once the putt has been made please pick up and move to the next hole.

2 putts maximum after that pick up the ball, and add a stroke.

After putting proceed to the next tee box (add score and put clubs away there).

Maximum score on any hole is double bogey, then pick up the ball.

To keep play moving, all players should take a golf cart.
