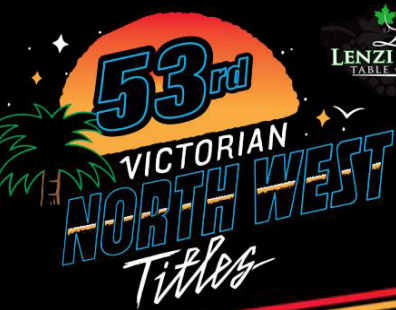

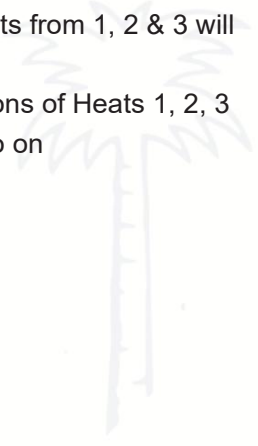

## HISTORY SNAP SHOT



### NORTH WEST TITLES - 50+ YEARS STRONG

*Noted for being the longest running karting open race meeting in Australia*

In 1972 Mildura Kart Club applied for and was granted its very first OPEN meeting at our current location, adjacent to the Mildura Airport. This meeting was to be held on the long weekend in June. The meeting was originally a one day event. During the mid-1980's the North West Victorian Title had gained so much popularity throughout the karting sector that the Mildura Kart Club chose to apply for the race meeting to be held over a longer period. The application for a two day event was granted, and The North West Victorian Titles became a two day event from that point forward. The Titles have been held on the Queen's birthday long weekend in June annually since, with this year being the 51st running of the event

In the past the event has attracted up to 300 competitors from all over Victoria, South Australia and with regular visitors from New South Wales, ACT and Queensland. Of recent times the event has attracted around 100 competitors, which has been an average for extreme remote regional karting events.



We still boast that in our heyday we had 24 karts run in the 200 Super and 24 karts run in the Twin Clubman classes in the same year which had never been seen at any other track within Australia. These classes are no longer run.

However, we still hold our own by running just the one Open meeting per year with support from local businesses some of whom have been with us for many years, some whom were previous club members and others who are new sponsors and we welcome you aboard.

North West Victorian Titles has always been a popular event in any driver's calendar, with last year being the 52nd running of the event, it was second to none and this year is shaping up to be the same.

We hope that you enjoy your weekend of racing and thank you for supporting us

Mildura had its first taste of 'Go-Karts' in 1960 when Barry Mills appeared at the Mildura Sporting Car Club with a few bits of steel with four wheels and a steering wheel and a motor attached. The bug soon caught on and many more karts "appeared" almost overnight.

Membership grew rapidly with almost all Sporting Car Club members purchasing or making their very own 'Go Karts'. Members would travel away to compete at other tracks and very soon the members built their own track then sought affiliation with the Governing body, and now is one of the oldest clubs with-in the Victorian Karting Association, an achievement the club is very proud of.

The track site originally was used as a sporting oval by the RAAF, before being transformed into a karting track. Originally the track was dirt, with the only safety feature being numerous bales of hay around the outside of the track. Eventually the dirt track was sealed with oil before the decision came to make it into a bitumen track in the mid 1970's.

In 2004 the track was re-surfaced and extended to 801 metres long and 8 metres wide, the grid capability was increased to 32 karts from this point; and a year later in 2005 the club rooms were also upgraded.

In 2009 the club installed lighting to the track, pit area and the grid to become one of the few tracks throughout Victoria that has the capability to race at night. The experience of racing under lights is what attracts the majority of competitors to the facility particularly for the clubs signature event, the North West Titles.

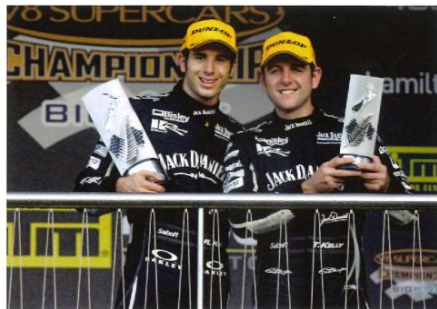
## MILDURA KART CLUB

UNPREDICTABLE weather and a soaked circuit couldn't stop the Mildura Kart Club from delivering another successful North West Titles over the long weekend as the wet track couldn't keep the karts in the shed.

Held across three days, the 52nd annual event delivered a mixture of challenges, highlights and community spirit as drivers from across different states descended on the region's premier karting facility.

Mildura Kart Club president Gary Rogers said the event was unlike any previous title in its half a century plus history.

"Friday was a big surprise," he said.

"We had a bit of rain come in and then Saturday we had to stop for about an hour and a half to clear the track as the water just wasn't coming off."

The rainfall marked the first ever North West Karting Titles to be run in the wet.

"The last time was back in the 70's and it got cancelled," said Rogers.

"There was a time at one point where we definitely thought we

were going to have to postpone till the next day, but everyone pulled together, cleared the track up and we got going again."

Despite the difficult conditions, the event ran smoothly with no major incidents, and finals were completed on Sunday in the day.

"Everyone seemed to enjoy the racing as there were no big accidents or anything like that," Rogers said.

"The pace was a little bit slower because of the weather, but it was good."

Among the highlights of the weekend was the push for female participants as part of the Girls Race Too initiative.

Eleven girls competed on a points-based system recognising the top three finishers.

"My daughter finished third and a couple of the teenage girls took out first and second," said Rogers.

"It's still under 10 percent entry from females, but that's something we're trying to drive forward."

Rogers added that the club is encouraging more women and girls to get involved by creating visible pathways and promoting good role models already in sport.

"A good example is my daughter,



she's at ballet on Saturday morning and then at the racetrack Sunday afternoon," he said.

"Everyone laughs when I pick her up from ballet with the kart trailer on the back."

Looking forward, the club will host a Karting Australia Come and Try day on July 6 aimed at kids aged

six to 10 and junior drivers up to 15.

"It's a great chance to introduce karting to new families with guidance from professional coaches," Rogers said.

"Then we've got our regular club championship rounds to finish out the year."

Rogers said future titles will look

to continue growth and attracting community support.

"We'd love to get more spectators coming out," he said.

"It's free to watch, you can talk to the drivers, see the karts up close, even sit in your warm car and watch by the track."

"It's a great day out."

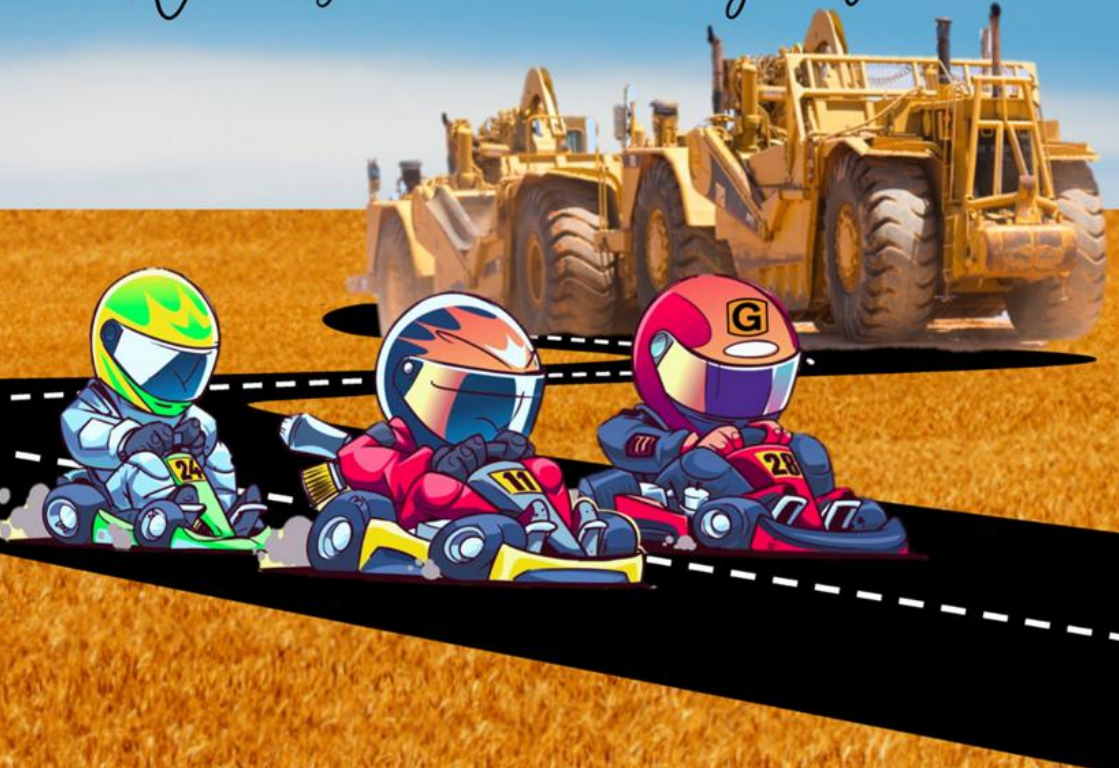

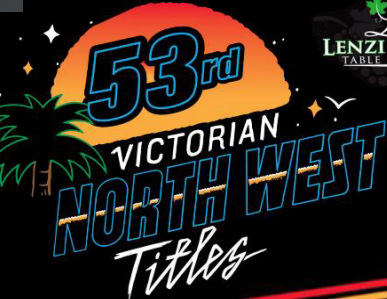
