

Sterett Creek Campground Rules

The following rules will help ensure a quality camping experience for all visitors:

Campsite Capacity:

- Maximum of **two (2) sleeping units per site**, i.e. one camper + one tent or two tents
 - Two RVs or campers are not allowed on one site at any time
- Maximum of **two (2) vehicles per campsite if both fit on the gravel**. Vehicles at sites must display current car pass at all times. Vehicles without a pass must park in the marina parking lot. **NO PARKING ON GRASS** next to or between sites at any time.
- Maximum 6 people per site

Vehicles/trailers are not to be parked on the grass or in roadways.

Due to excessive ruts in the grass and damage to our mowers we do not allow any vehicles to park on grass. Additional parking is available in main marina lot for vehicles and boat trailers.

Quiet hours are from 10 pm – 6 am

Sound carries farther than you think on the lakefront. At 10 pm please turn down music and keep conversations to speaking voices. Please notify staff if you are having any issues with other campers. We can't address what we don't know about!

Dogs are permitted in Campground; maximum 2 per site.

Dogs must be kept **on leash at all times**. Any dogs which are off leash, aggressive, noisy or bothersome will need to be removed from property immediately upon request of Sterett Creek staff. No refunds will be given if customer is required to vacate property.

Pick up all trash at your site and deposit in dumpsters before leaving.

Please do not burn trash or leave trash in fire rings.

Fires must be contained in the provided fire rings.

Firewood is available for purchase at the marina. Dead wood or downed trees in the woods may be collected for fires. Cutting of standing trees, branches, or bushes is expressly prohibited by the Army Corps of Engineers. Chainsaws are also not allowed in woods.

ATV's or motorized dirt bikes are not allowed to be operate anywhere on the property.

This is an Army Corps of Engineers rule. Golf carts or utility vehicles on the roadways are allowed if **operated by a licensed driver**.

Checkout time is 1:00 pm on the day of departure so that the next campers may check in by 2:00 pm.

Benton County Sheriff's Department and Corp Rangers periodically patrol the property to help ensure the safety of our guests.
