*Lavender Breeze. light, fresh lavender and orchid blend

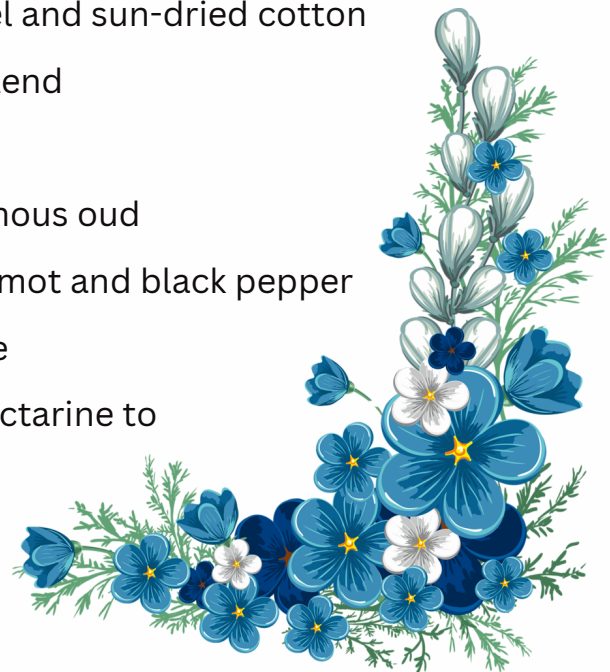
McIntosh Apple. refreshing classic mountain apple
