New Business: Tim

- **Hesperia Lake update-**Tim and Quannah are attending the Hesperia Recreation and Park District Board meeting this evening to represent us and speak about the fact that we still don't have access to the Val Shearer Arena as Hesperia Lake Park remains closed. We did find out on our way this evening that there was a "soft" opening at the lake this afternoon, however their post on social media indicates that the Lake store, fishing, equestrian center and John Swisher Center remain closed during this time. We did receive a picture of the arena which looks like they took a gannon of a tractor and ran it across the dirt and it appears that we may have to do some rock removal and a work day/weekend the first weekend of May to help get our arena back in shape for our May show.
- **April show recap-** we had a great day and a great show with 54 riders and we are so very thankful again for Kristina and Tom of Pioneer Equestrian Center for their generosity in hosting our first show of the season.
 1. Warm up area & foot traffic-the Pioneer Equestrian warm up area goes directly into the arena and we need to be mindful about our little ones getting ready to ride but our lead line folks need to make sure that they are staying close to the rail going into the arena and not standing in the middle of those riders trying to warm up their horses.
 2. Cleaning up after ourselves-we did a great job of cleaning up after ourselves. Reminder, that no matter where we are please pick up your manure and any trash. Thank you all for being considerate guests.
 3. Parking & overflow-the overflow parking is a great place for smaller vehicles to park and leaves more room for larger vehicles. Don't drive between the barns. Overflow parking is not for lunging your horses.
 4. Paying attention to signage-read the signs. If the sign says not to ride beyond the sign, then stop and turn around. Be respectful of the facility and their boarders.
 5. Round Pens- we are not renting the entire facility only the arena and "warm-up" area so please be respectful of this and do not use their round pens.
- **Complaints-** Please direct them to Tim.

Comments from the Floor:

- Krystal- asked if there is a specific area designated for lunging and can we look into that should we need to use their facility again in the future then this way we are aware.
- Makayla- wanted to let everyone know that Kristina of Pioneer Equestrian Center complimented the Hesperia Wranglers as we were great with cleaning up after themselves.
- Jennifer-asked if there was room for two more people for the queen's cattle drive. Tonii said she would have to talk to Tim since she had already given him the headcount and he had purchased the food.
- Carissa- asked when sponsorships are due and Carol and Tonii confirmed that they are due no later than the July show. Carol and Tonii also let everyone know that if they do not turn in their sponsorship forms with their sponsorship monies then you will not get any awards.
