New Business: Tim

- **Recap of the most recent show-** we will continue to take pre-entries only until after the September show. We will continue to evaluate the temperatures to determine if we will run any time only's. Thank you for ensuring you are hydrating your horses and giving them breaks too.
- Tonii- please remember that when you or your child are tying your horses at the trailer that you are tying them so that they aren't tied so long that they are going to hurt themselves. Also please remember to be cautious when you're riding and don't run your horses outside the arena because there are squirrel holes and hard ground that can also hurt you or your horses.
- Kimberlee- was once new and remember that it is ok to ask for help because everyone here is always happy to help each other.
- We discussed Rule #22 regarding helmets and the need for them as a requirement for our insurance. It is also important that riders remember that when wearing a helmet when mounted only protects you if it is indeed on and buckled. If you don't want to wear your helmet properly when you aren't in the arena then you should be on your own two feet and not your horses four.
- Makayla- we need to keep the entry area clear so the rider exiting and entering are able to do so. Our entry gate is not an alley way & we need to remember that it is not.
- Sponsorships- thank you to everyone that turned in their sponsorships, please make sure that you get your required four meetings before October and your six shows. Please remember that if you have anyone that wants to do additional sponsorships after your required ones have been met, we are always open to additional as that helps our awards budget.
- **Tim-** thanked Makayla again for their generosity in donating another \$250 to the Kinnard Scholarship fund from their July barrel race. They did have 48 riders and it seems that the heat is getting to everyone so their numbers were also down this month.

Comments from the Floor:

- Carol- we need to stay consistent with our one-minute gate call. You need to visibly be trying to get in the gate not still at your trailer. Ana wanted to clarify that if they do not make the 1-minute gate call do they get disqualified from that event. Tonii reminded everyone that if you communicate with us that you are having trouble, we can roll you to the bottom of the class but if you don't let us know then we can't. Tim said that even when he was a kid you had to be at the gate no matter where you were you needed to be at the arena and ready to enter.
- Abby- inquired as to the date for the Tehachapi parade & Tonii clarified that the parade is on Saturday morning. We will attend the Friday night performance, the parade Saturday morning, the Saturday evening performance and depending on the time we will also attend the Sunday performance.
- Quannah- tries to ensure that she always calls each age group three or four times to ensure that everyone is ready to go.
