There will be a Tri-Tip luncheon on Sunday with tickets for lunch being \$20 & children under 3 eat free. We are working on the cost to just come & watch which would include the program book.

New Business: Tim

- **Hesperia Lake update**-unfortunately the meeting was nonproductive. We will be drafting a letter with our attorney demanding the 21-year-old contract be complied with and to get us the user agreement. It doesn't appear that we will have a user agreement anytime soon, so thankfully Pioneer Equestrian has agreed to continue to host us. With that comes the need to remember that we are their guests in their home.
- **June show recap**-
 1. it is imperative that we remember to pick up after ourselves and to clean up your horse poop. DO NOT clean out your trailers.
 2. Parking- please remember that two horse bumper pulls should be in the "overflow" area & those not in the overflow should be mindful of not leaving too much space and vehicles not pulling a trailer should be parked up front, not in the back.
 3. Dress Code- please remember that we do have a dress code. This means familiarize yourselves with it, there are no tank tops, no bra straps, no midriffs, etc. The dress code applies to our coaches as well so please make sure that you are following the dress code.
 4. Speed limit in & out, slow down & we need to be mindful that there are children and again be respectful because we are in a neighborhood.
 5. Please keep in mind that if you do not board your horse at Pioneer Equestrian the only areas we are to use are the warmup arena & the arena itself. This means please do not use their cross ties, round pens, hitching posts, etc.
 6. Do not approach the volunteers in the show booth area with complaints and do not take it upon yourselves to yell at or raise voices at the folks in the booth as they are working & are trying to pay attention to what is going on in the arena. This means do not interrupt & ask for times or that someone isn't in dress code, these all should be directed to Tim.
 7. Please remember to communicate if you aren't going to make your gate call. Tonii suggested that folks communicate with a board member so that they can let us know that you're running late or trying to get your horse watered or you have a tack change so that we can move you down or fit you in.

- **Sponsorships**- please remember they are due no later than July show. Please remember that if you submit your sponsorship monies but you do not return the forms you will not get a rider bucket.
