- **Hesperia Lake-** the arena is open, but we still don't have a "user agreement" for our dates. We have continued to attend the Park Board meetings & have attended some of the City of Hesperia meetings. We have retained Sherri Kastilahn as our attorney so that we have representation when we meet with the HRPD representatives on Friday, June 12th at 2:30pm via ZOOM.

- **Upcoming show-** held at Pioneer due to not having a user agreement with HRPD
  1. Pioneer Equestrian- we need to pay them for the water we have been using for our shows.
  2. We need to pay for the porta potties again. Tim had Tonii reach out regarding the porta potty's & it is tentatively \$200 per month for two that would be serviced weekly. Is this what we want to do since we aren't sure how much longer we will be at Pioneer, especially since we are going in blind to the meeting on Friday. Everyone agreed that we need to have Tonii confirm that this is going to be the amount moving forward so that we know what our plan of action is.
- **Chuck Wagon-** Tim will reach out to Shelby Collins about running the chuck wagon again for our June show.
- **Shade at Pioneer-** Pop ups can be placed behind the chuck wagon area, but must be secured and they are looking into possibly some shade cloth in some areas to create more shade.

Virginia also indicated that she will start looking for grant writers and what we would need to do to for something of this nature.
- Summer- has a friend that is also not getting their annual "user agreement" from HRPD and what they are hearing is that the HRPD are going to make the contracts unreasonable so that no one will sign them & then HRPD can declare the Hesperia Lake area as unsafe & unusable so they can develop it as they see fit.
- Daryl- asked if we have a confirmed date for the trail ride at Inspiration Point in Wrightwood and Tonii explained that she and Carol hadn't had a chance to look at dates as of yet. Daryl also wanted to know if HRPD ask us to pay for water are we going to ask them to pay for our fuel and our time when they ask us to do work for their events utilizing our personal water truck since HRPD no longer has one.
