- We would like to have a July trail ride from Inspiration Point, most likely the side with the fire road so that it's wide enough to make sure it isn't scary for everyone.

**Queens: Tonii**

- We had a great time at our annual Hesperia Wranglers Queen Clinic- we are so thankful for the clinicians that we had, our stock contractor- Shannon Finch, horsemanship- Kristina Phipps, public speaking- Quannah Schuller and hair makeup- Cheyenne Bachelier with some assistance from Elizabeth Schuller. We have received positive feedback from everyone.
- Our queens did a great job representing us at the Yucaipa Rodeo on Saturday evening.
- Tonii will be setting up some horsemanship practices with Carol & Kristina and then she and Quannah will be setting up some dates for speech & modeling practice.

## New Business: Tim

- **Hesperia Lake update**-we don't really have an update. We attended the Hesperia City Council meeting last night and they had noted in their closed session that they were negotiating with the HRPD for them to purchase the Hesperia Lake Park instead of leasing it like they have over the last several years. We have submitted our dates as we are required however they still haven't given us the "user" agreement and we did show them our contract where we gave the HRPD a piece of property in exchange for lifetime use of the Val Shearer Arena. It doesn't appear that the arena has any real damage other than they put sand and rocks in the arena. We don't want to have to sue the HRPD but if we have to, we have to. Also need to thank Melanie & Bristol for attending the Hesperia City Council meeting and speaking on behalf of reopening the Val Shearer Arena.
- **May show recap**- we had a great day and a great show again with over 50 riders again. We want to once again thank Kristina and Tom of Pioneer Equestrian Center for their generosity in hosting us while we continue to remain displaced.
  1. Please keep in mind that if you do not board your horse at Pioneer Equestrian the only areas we are to use are the warmup arena & the arena itself. This means please do not use their cross ties, round pens, hitching posts, etc.
  2. Please be mindful that during the early morning we do have our lead line group so please keep to the outer edge.
  3. Cleaning up after ourselves- Reminder, that no matter where we are please pick up your manure and any trash, we weren't as good at this show as we were the first show. Please remember that we need to be considerate guests.
  4. Parking & overflow-the overflow parking is a great place for smaller vehicles to park and leaves more room for larger vehicles. Overflow parking is not for lunging your horses. Please be mindful of space when you have bigger trailers and all cars should be parked in front of the red barn area and no trailers other than the folks that bring the tractor should be up front. Tonii and Shelby's vehicles were parked in the area of the announcer & chuck wagon areas as they have the equipment for those spaces.
  5. Paying attention to signage-read the signs. If the sign says not to ride beyond the sign, then stop and turn around & do not move the signage. Be respectful of the facility and their boarders.
  6. We do not have an alleyway at Pioneer and the walk-in walk out at Pioneer's arena just like at the Val Shearer Arena and we need to make sure that we are following our show rules. Keep in mind that even though we aren't at home we need to treat it as the same, this also means we can't have riders or spectators approaching us in the "booth" as we are trying to watch the arena.
  7. We need to keep things moving and we should keep our lead liners with one on pattern and two waiting inside the arena like we normally do. Tim prefers that we only announce who is up and who is next and after the first couple of classes everyone should know who they follow.
  8. Keep in mind that we do move to our "summer hours" beginning with our June show, which means that sign ups start at 7am and we ride at 8am. Also, for our queens this means that means that they will need to be warmed up and ready to ride at 7:30.
- **Meetings**- please remember that the show rules regarding meetings did change this year that you must attend at least two of your four required meetings in person. So, if you have already attended four meetings and they have all been on ZOOM you still need to attend two in person.
- **Scholarships**-Tonii read a thank you text from Lyndsie Rodriguez, Lybertie & Natalie's older sister, thanking us for choosing her. Melanie also wanted to say that Lyndsie is the Valedictorian for Sultana High School.
