Hesperia Lake update- we received a “draft agreement” on July 2nd & we went from 7 pages to 17 page and after reviewing it advised them this agreement was not reasonable and did not conform to the 2005 Contract between the HRPD & Hesperia Wranglers. We gave them direction on what we would accept and they in turn came back to us on July 10th @ 11:08 am as we were trying to prepare for our show on July 11th & therefore, we let them know that we would review it and respond as time allowed after our show. We reviewed the agreement on Sunday and sent an email advising them that we weren’t going to sign this as there were multiple things that we didn’t agree with and we definitely couldn’t sign something that ended in the middle of our show season for 2027. We let them know that for that reason, we were again asking the board to seriously reconsider our prior proposal to extend the agreement through December 31, 2027. We also wanted them to address the ongoing facility concerns, which included the water faucets remaining padlocked, (Tim expressed to our membership that the HRPD had used twice as much water watering the soccer field at Hesperia Lake Park as we had used for our entire show season last year, the Hesperia Days Rodeo and a double-header High School/Jr. High School rodeo) and the continued lack of porta potties in the equestrian area is also a significant concern. We also again asked that they review our concerns and address them as quickly as possible so that everyone in the community could continue to move forward with another outstanding Hesperia Days Rodeo.

- **July show recap- Carol**
 1. **Announcer stand** is not a thoroughfare — only one staircase side should be used
 2. **Gate readiness:** riders must be at the gate when their group is called; gate calls nearly issued for repeat offenders
 3. **Equipment:** tack/bell boots falling off repeatedly across 6 events is unacceptable — use tape/Velcro to secure
 4. **Lead line flow:** maintain one on pattern + two waiting inside to keep events moving
