New Business: Tim

- **Show Rules-** review the changes to the show rules for 2025. They are currently posted on the website.
 - A.) Regarding work hours- "Riders must sign up for an event to work, if not already assigned an event prior to the beginning of the show. Points for the day will be forfeited if an event is not worked.
 - B.) Rule # 9- Riders must be at the gate and ready to ride when their class is called; riders will be given a 1-minute gate call. The event timer will be started, and after 1-minute, if the rider is not in the arena, he/she will be disqualified for that event. After the gate is closed and the arena is clear, the timers will be ready. Once in the arena, riders have 1 additional minute to cross the timing line; riders who exceed this time limit will receive a disqualification for the event and will be excused from the arena.
 - C.) Rule #12- A rider shall not enter the arena until the prior rider has COMPLETELY exited the arena. **Horses must enter the arena under control and at a walk, or the rider will be excused from the arena and disqualified for that event. There is no alleyway.** No more than one horse in the arena at any time, with the exception of Lead Line.
 - D.) Rule # 28- Maximum of one (1) parent/coach will be permitted in the arena for novice class riders (Lil Wranglers and Youth/Adult Novice). No coaches will be permitted in the arena for any other class.
 - E.) Rule #31 last Note: Green horse points are on the horse and rider combination. Therefore, the same green horse must be ridden each show of the season with the same rider. The Board reserves the right to make an exception if the green horse in question has a vet note.
 - F.) Regarding entry fees- Grounds fees are \$5 per horse and rider. Note: There are "No Refunds" unless there are extenuating circumstances as determined by the Board.
- Barn Bash- is also on March 8th, which is our first show. We would like to encourage our members to support o this event as it goes towards our junior livestock area of our San Bernardino County Fairgrounds and promotes agriculture and our western way of life.

Comments from the Floor:

Makayla- is looking to host a WCBRA sanctioned barrel race the Sunday after our show and there will be an open group and a novice group, (novice will be geared toward novice people).

Ana- excited to get this show season started.

Jaidyn- is part of the Future Farmers of America (FFA) and is also going to be at Barn Bash this year.

Quannah- suggested that we think about not having “time only’s” for the first show as there are numerous people and our queens that will be attending Barn Bash in an effort to save time.

Kerri- let’s keep working on our new shirt designs and looking forward to having them at the first show of the year.

Tonii-shared the new t-shirt designs that she and Tim both had on and let everyone know that the new shirts will be \$15 each, baseball sleeve shirts will be \$20, and hoodie sweatshirts/zip-up sweatshirts will be \$30. The queens are also having a “blow-out sale” on the remaining stock of their baseball sleeve shirts with the new club t-shirt design for \$10 each.
