- We have our dates of May 16th & 17th for our Queen clinic and June 27th & 28th for our pageant this year.

New Business: Tim

- **Barn Bash:** we received the sponsorship package for the 2026 Barn Bash and after reviewing what we did last year, it looks like we should also do that again this year. The “Choice” sponsorship package for \$500.00 is still the best package as it offers six dinner tickets and your name on the Barn Bash banner that is hung during the San

Bernardino County Fair. Tonii made the motion to have the Hesperia Wranglers Queens sponsor the “Choice” package again for \$500 & Diane 2nd the motion- M/C. Virginia made the motion that the Hesperia Wranglers sponsor the “Choice” package again this year for \$500 & Ana 2nd the motion- M/C.

- **First show, March 14th-** we are still uncertain as to when Hesperia Lake will be open so that we can start working the arena as it is going to take a lot of work. We were going to attend the Hesperia Parks Board meeting last Wednesday; however, it was cancelled as they didn’t have a quorum and the meeting is supposed to be rescheduled but we don’t have a date as to when. We do feel that once the date & time for the rescheduled meeting is posted that we need to get as many folks as possible to attend the meeting so that we can ask the questions about the status. After much discussion it was decided that we will wait one more week & try to get the answers that we need & if we aren’t able to get the necessary answers we will cancel our March show and make April a double point show. Tim did indicate that if we have to cancel the March show, he will then contact our insurance to remove that date and put a couple of dates in the month of December to cover ourselves. It was also decided that depending on the outcome of the Hesperia Parks Board meeting answers we will make a post on social media that we are either moving forward with preparing for our first show of the season or we are cancelling it and making April a double point show.

Closed session: began @ 6:51pm and ended @ 7:01

- Tim was pleased to report that all new /renewal memberships received were approved.

Comments from the Floor:

- Tonii- we ordered the bronc halter noseband and wither strap for Starr due to an oversight on our awards.
- Carol- in regards to year-end awards she was contacted by the family of one of our Youth Novice riders that received a Tough 1 saddle pad as part of her awards and was told that the seam down the center of the pad is crooked. Tonii asked Carol if she could please get the pad and confirm that this is in fact correct and then we can move forward with potentially contacting Tough 1 to have the pad replaced. Carol also let us know that the spur straps that were purchased for the 3rd place winner in the Cool Kids age group were extremely oversized and she has the pictures showing this, which Tonii has seen also, and the company that the spur straps were ordered from are having the winner measure their boots so that the company can make a replacement pair to fit properly.

Carol’s last concern was that we have some folks attending our flag practices that aren’t members and have been selected to be part of the team but still haven’t submitted their membership. In order to be part of the flag team and participate in any further practices it was suggested that they have their membership paperwork submitted. Carol also suggested that we have a set schedule for these practices so that people can prioritize them and be available to attend them. It was also suggested that we utilize different arenas so that we can begin getting everyone’s horses acclimated to different arenas and different surroundings. Tonii indicated that in the last group text we had decided to use the Val Shearer/ Hesperia Wranglers Arena at Hesperia Lake Park for the next practice which was supposed to be on March 8th but since we don’t have any idea of when the arena will be available, we are in a holding pattern.
