

July 2018 Block of the Month

River Log Cabin

[From Missouri Star Quilts]

TO PRINT: Use the printer icon in the header immediately above this document and open Adobe Reader when requested. [DO NOT USE your browser printer command.]

Fabrics Needed: This makes an 8-½" square block (unfinished)

Cream Tone on tone -- 1-½" strip (subcut into 2-½", 3-½", 5-½", and 6-½")

Red, Cream, and Blue print -- 2-½" strip (subcut into 2-½", 3-½", 5-½", 6-½", and 8-½")

1. Sew a 2-½" cream rectangle to the 2-½" square color print.
2. Next sew the 3-½" cream rectangle to the adjoining side of the 2-½" color print square.
3. Next sew the 3-½" colored print rectangle to a colored side of the 2-½" center square.
4. Follow this with the 5-½" colored print rectangle to the adjoining colored side of center square.
5. Continue to create the log cabin by sewing the cream rectangles (5-½" and 6-½") to the cream colored sides of the block.
6. Then finish with the colored print rectangles (6-½" and 8-½") sewn to the colored side of the block.
7. NOTE: This block is made like a regular log cabin, however the 2 different sizes of strips make the "River" curve through the quilt as you sew the blocks together.
