

# January 2019 Block of the Month

## Sundance by Rob Appell

(6" finished)

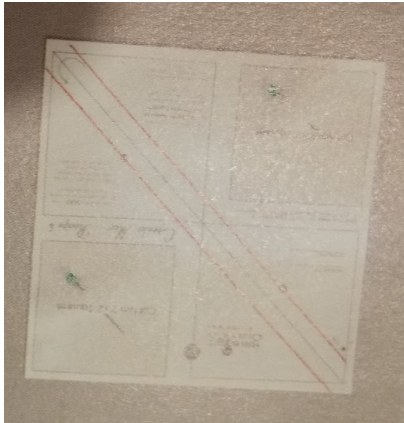
### **Materials: Included in your packet**

2 5" print squares (batik)

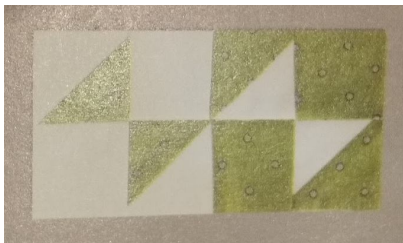
2 5" white squares

2 pages of Moda Cupcake recipe Foundation paper pattern pad #4

1. Layer a print 5" square with a background square - right sides together. Make sure background square is on top. Pin 1 foundation paper on the top. Shorten the stitch length on your machine (suggestion 1.8).



2. Follow the arrows on the foundation pattern and stitch on the dotted lines. Cut on all the solid lines beginning with the outside of the square, then cut into quarters, cut on the diagonal and finally cut out the 2" squares at marked on the foundation piece. Each foundation paper makes half of one block so you'll need to use two foundations and the second set of white and batik square included in the packet to complete one block.



3. Lay out the two halves of the block, being aware of how each is oriented. Sew the two halves together to complete the block.
