Oblique

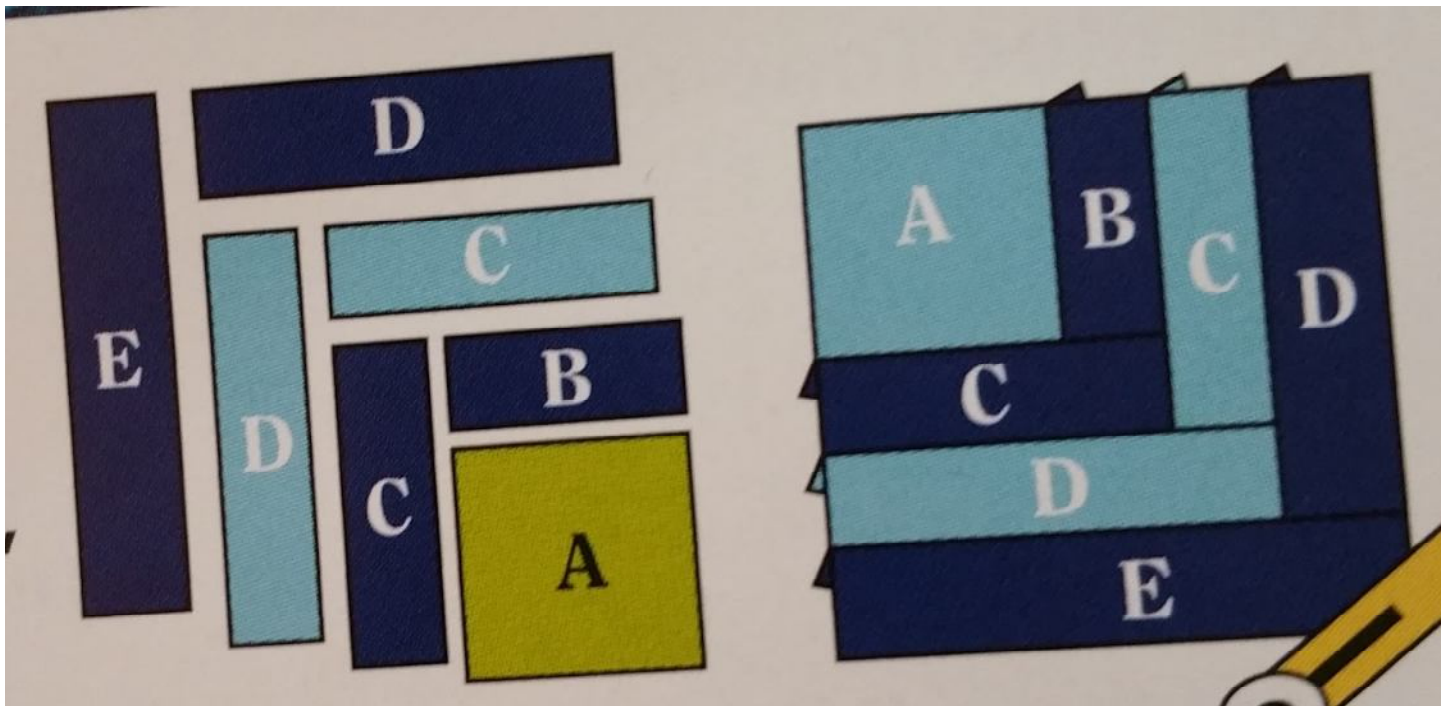
Fabrics Needed:

Olive green print: 2 squares (A) 4" x 4"

Dark Blue: 4 rectangles (B) 2" x 4"
4 rectangles (C) 2" x 5-½"
4 rectangles (D) 2" x 7"
4 rectangles (E) 2" x 8-½"

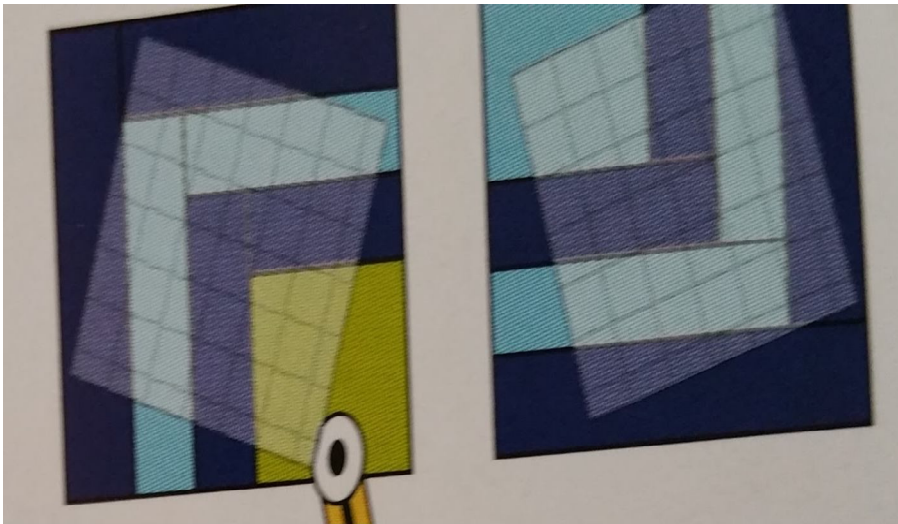
Blue & white print: 2 squares (A) 4" x 4"
4 rectangles (C) 2" x 5-½"
4 rectangles (D) 2" x 7"

1. Sew sections 1 and 2 together as shown in the picture [these 2 sections are regular log cabin blocks with the center color and the direction of attaching the strips changed].



2. Place a 6-½" ruler or template on a section 1; **turn the ruler slightly clockwise and trim as shown.** Repeat to trim the remaining section 1.

For each section 2, turn the ruler slightly counterclockwise and trim as shown.



3. Sew the sections together as shown to complete the block.
