

May 2019 Block of the Month

Perfect Petals

Fabrics Needed: Black, White, Kaffe Fassett Floral with coordinating center color

[12-1/2" unfinished]

From Black cut:

- G. 2 rectangles 1-1/2" x 10-1/2"
- H. 2 rectangles 1-1/2" x 12-1/2"

From White cut

- B. 16 squares 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"
- D. 4 rectangles 1-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- E. 4 rectangles 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"

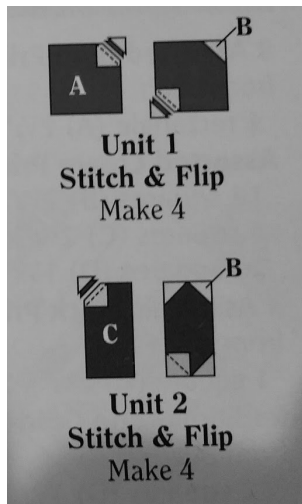
From Floral cut:

- A. 4 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- C. 4 rectangles 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

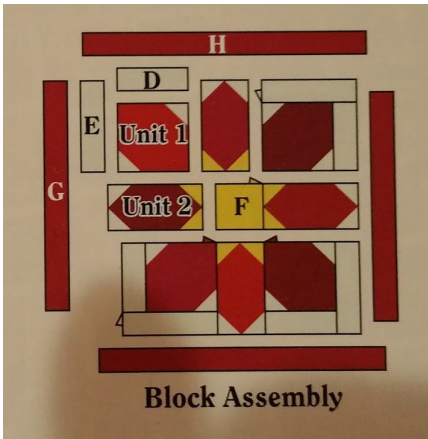
From the coordinating color cut:

- B. 8 squares 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"
- F. 1 square 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

1. Unit 1 - sew small white rectangles (B) to opposite corners of 4 squares (A). Make 4 Unit 1.



2. Unit 2 - sew small white rectangles (B) to 2 adjoining corners of 4 rectangles C.
 - Sew small colored rectangles (B) to 2 adjoining corners of 4 rectangles C. Make 4 Unit 2.



3. Attach pieces D and E to the Unit 1 squares as shown in the diagram. (Hint - be sure the floral fabric in the Unit 1 squares is turned in the correct direction before you sew on these white pieces.)
4. Assemble the pieces into 3 rows (Unit 1, Unit 2, Unit 1; Unit 2, Square colored fabric, Unit 2; Unit 1, Unit 2, Unit 1). (Hint: Be sure to square up the pieces before you sew into rows.)
5. Sew the rows together as above and then attach the black pieces (G and H) to the sides and the top and bottom.
