In addition to presenting three honorary degrees to outstanding educators from other campuses during Commencement exercises at both the Reno and Las Vegas campuses, the University of Nevada will pre-sent three Distinguished Nevadan awarded to a trio of its outstanding citizens.

The Reno campus Commencement speaker, Morris Hadley yesterday received his honor-ary Doctor of Laws degree. He is chairman of the board of the Carnegie Corporation of New York; was a fellow of the

New York; was a fellow of the Yale Corporation (governing board of that university) and received an honorary degree from Yale in 1963. Currently he is a member of the New York law firm of Mulbank, Tweed, Hadley & McCloy.

Honored yesterday at the Reno campus also was Dr. Robert Heizer, a pioneer in Nevada archeology and now a professor of anthropology at the University of California, Berkeley, who had conferred upon him an honorary Doctor upon him an honorary Doctor of Science degree in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the pre-history of Nevada. He is currently special adviser to the University of Nevada's department

of anthropology.

The NSU Commencement speaker, Dr. Malcolm Love, president of San Diego State College, will be awarded tomorrow at the Las Vegas tomorrow at the Las Vegas campus an honorary Doctor of Laws degree. He is a former president of the University of Nevada. He has been president of San Diego State since 1952 and prior to that was Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Denver from 1948 to 1950 and Dean of Administration and the College of Liberal Arts at Illinois. Honored tomorrow also at Las Vegas will be Archie C. Grant, veteran member of the University Board of Regents who will receive a Distinguished Newsday award. tinguished Nevadan award. A member of the board for 12 years and chairman the past years and chairman the past eight, Grant is prominent in civic, state and national affairs. He served as a Senator in the State Legislature in 1941 and in the State Assembly in 1943. He has also served on the Nevada State Planning Commission, the Nevada State Park Commission and the State Board of Education.

A Distinguished Nevadan award was conferred yesterday at Reno upon Jean McElrath, a blind author of Wells, Nev., in recognition of her outstanding contribution to the cultural and literary advancement

tural and literary advancement of the state. Her literary talent has resulted in a recently published book, "Aged ches capturing the spirit of Nevada and the West. One of the state's most productive journalists, she is a frequent free lance contributor to west-

ern newspapers and magazines. Katherine Mackay Hawkins, granddaughter of John W. Mackay, famed pioneer of the Comstock Lode and daughter of Clarence H. Mackay, received a Distinguished Nevadan award at the Reno Campus yesterday also in recognition of her out-standing cultural and social services to the community and state. She is founder of the Washoe Medical Center Woman's and served four years on the board of the Nevada State Hospital.
