“Revelation” means revealing
“Apocalypse” means revealing.

The Book of Revelation is the revealing of information about Jesus.

Many people have not understood this book and tried to make it into a scary futuristic prophecy of doom on the world. This is not what the book is about.

Revelation reveals:

- What happened at the Cross in the spirit realm.
- How Jesus deals with:
 - The Old Testament dead
 - Satan, Sin and Death
 - Unfaithful Israel/Jerusalem
 - Spiritual Warfare

The book of Revelation is not written in linear time. It is the revealing of information **retold** throughout the book from different perspectives. If you try to make it out to be linear time, you make it say something it does not say.

Revelation 11 is an allegory of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The 2 Witnesses are the beginning and end of Jesus' earthly physical ministry.

They are not 2 futuristic people.

The 1st Witness

Jesus' baptism

John the baptizer baptizes Jesus.
The Holy Spirit fills Jesus.
This is the 1st witness.

The 2nd Witness

Jesus' crucifixion: D-B-R

Jesus shed His Blood and pays for sin.
Jesus defeats Satan.
Jesus defeats Death
Jesus ascends to heaven
The Kingdom comes
Jesus and His saints reign

When did this happen? AD 33

Baptism =	Death, Burial, Resurrection The circumcision of Christ. Where sins are remitted, When the Holy Spirit is given. The Holy Spirit is the seal, the sign of one's relationship with God, not baptism itself. Faith in the D-B-R of Jesus; Turning to Jesus as Lord; Baptism = Saved.
