WE PROFESS WHAT WE BELIEVE

from The Nicene Creed, 325 AD

LEADER: People of God, what do you believe about God?

PEOPLE: We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.

LEADER: What do you believe about Jesus Christ?

PEOPLE: We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of the Father before all worlds; God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God; begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made.

LEADER: What do you believe about the salvation of Christ?

PEOPLE: We believe that for us men and for our salvation, Christ came down from heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried; and the third day He rose again, according to the Scriptures.

LEADER: What do you believe about Christ's ascension?

PEOPLE: We believe that Christ ascended into heaven, and sits on the right hand of the Father; and He shall come again, with glory, to judge the quick and the dead; whose kingdom shall have no end.

LEADER: What do you believe about the Holy Spirit?

PEOPLE: We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of Life; who proceeds from the Father and the Son; who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped

and glorified; who spoke by the prophets.

LEADER: What do you believe about the church?

PEOPLE: We believe in one universal and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins.

LEADER: What is your future hope?

PEOPLE: We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come.

ALL: (with a loud voice) Amen.
