CSEA ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to seek office, a member must meet the following requirements:

- be at least 18 years of age;
- be a member in good standing of the Association since June 1 of last year;
- shall not be a member of a competing labor association or union since June 1 of last year;
- shall not currently be serving a disciplinary penalty imposed by the Judicial Board of CSEA; and
- must not have been the subject of a bonding claim by the Association or disqualified from being covered by the Association's surety bond.

PROTESTS

Any member believing themselves aggrieved by any aspect of the nomination or election process may file a written protest postmarked or electronically with the appropriate supervising Election Committee as set forth below within ten (10) calendar days after the member knew or should have known of the act or omission. The supervising election committee will send all other candidates affected by the protest a copy of the protest and give adequate time for responses.
