The Trempealeau County ATV trails are a series of private trail systems that offer something for every skill level, from the inclines of the bluffs to the valleys and swamps.

All registrations post marked by the early bird date listed below per event will be entered in a drawing to be reimbursed the cost of that event (*Must include payment at time of registering, winner will be reimbursed day of the event*).

SATURDAY JUNE 26 and/or June 27 (Rain date July 17 & 18)

SEPTEMBER 18 & 19 (THE 2 DAY RIDE)

The September event is a full weekend of riding. Registration for this ride includes food and beverages. Due to planning and preparation, this ride is limited to 200 machines.

PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED-NO SAME DAY REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

9:30am - Riders Meeting ~ 10:00am Ride begins

- \$100.00 per Machine
- \$50.00 per Passenger over 12 yrs old, under 12 is Free
 - EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION – Must be post marked by September 1, 2021
 - REGISTRATION – Must be post marked by September 9, 2021 – NO EXCEPTIONS!!
 - *There will be NO ONE-DAY PASSES for this event. You may ride for one day, but the fee will remain the same.*
 - *Event includes: Full weekend of Riding, Home cooked food and Beverages (beer on Saturday night), Camping (No electric or water hookups, and must bring firewood), Showers and live Auction*
 - **Saturday** - Coffee/donuts, Lunch and Dinner
 - **Sunday** - Hot breakfast and Lunch

NON-REFUNDABLE - No Refunds will be given for either event due to the planning required. We will however, grant credits in the event of inclement weather.

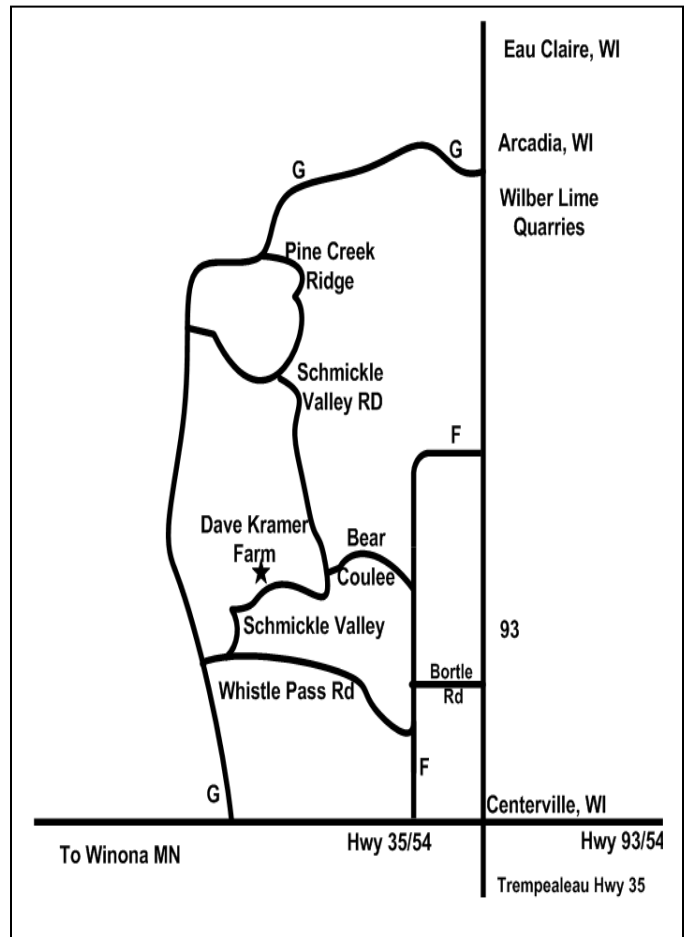

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. A HELMET IS REQUIRED TO RIDE!!!!
All riders must wear a DOT, SNELL, or other approved helmet, protective eyewear, and over the ankle foot wear.
2. GENERATORS allowed, but only QUIET 4 STROKE MODELS AFTER 10 P.M.
3. 10 MPH speed limit on camp grounds & farm yards.
4. The ATV Club is NOT responsible for accidents or thefts.
5. NO ALCOHOL is permitted during the ride and do not leave any litter on the trails.
6. You MUST STAY ON TRAILS and NO PASSING at any time.
7. Committee decisions are final.
8. Rules may be added/changed at the discretion of the ATV Club.
9. All attachments (plows etc.) MUST be removed
10. Above all, please use common sense and practice safety at all times.
11. Riders MUST BE 12 years of age w/parental supervision and must have a safety certificate as required by state law.
12. All riders under the age of 18 MUST have a parent's signature – * See registration form.

NOTE: There will be several groups for you to choose from – fast, medium, or slow. Our trails are privately owned and NOT state trails, so a state trail pass is NOT required. Most are heavily wooded with a single lane and have steep hill climbs and easy-outside trails. These trails are truly unique, making the ride fun and challenging, even to the experienced rider.
