Please Join Us for our 2026 ATV Trail Rides

The Trempealeau County ATV trails are a series of private trail systems that offer something for every skill level, from the inclines of the bluffs to the valleys and swamps.

SATURDAY JUNE 27, 1 day only, (Rain date July 11)

9:30am - Riders Meeting ~ 10:00am Ride begins

- \$40 for the day, regardless of number of passengers
- Event includes: Day of Riding, Showers and Camping *(No electric or water hookups, and must bring own fire wood)*
- TCATV will not be providing any meals for the June ride
- **Registration for this ride is DAY OF, pay at the event, prior payment will not be accepted**

Tom Kramer Memorial Ride - August 29 & 30 (Rain date Sept 12 & 13)

9:30am - Riders Meeting ~ 10:00am Ride begins

The August event is a full weekend of riding. Registration for this ride includes food and beverages. Due to planning and preparation, this ride is limited to 125 machines.

A NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT OF ONLY \$35 per MACHINE & \$35 per PASSENGER IS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF PRE- REGISTRATION -No Same Day Registration will be accepted!!

If both the ride and the rain date for the ride should be canceled by the TCATV club, the deposits will be credited to the following year Memorial Ride

THE BALANCE OF \$130 per MACHINE & \$75 per PASSENGER IS DUE THE DAY OF THE RIDE

- \$165 per Machine *(send \$35 only for pre-registration)*
- \$110 per Passenger over 12 yrs old, under 12 is Free *(send \$35 only for pre-registration)*
- EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION : Registrations post marked by August 1, 2026 will be entered into the Early Bird Drawing. Winner of Early Bird Drawing will receive a refund for any paid deposits.
- Pre-Registraion is required – Must be post marked by August 19, 2026, NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- Event includes: Full weekend of Riding, Home cooked food and Beverages *(beer on Saturday night)*, Camping *(No electric or water hookups, and must bring firewood)*, Showers and live Auction
 - **Saturday** - Coffee/pastries, Lunch and Dinner
 - **Sunday** - Hot breakfast and Lunch
- There will be NO ONE-DAY PASSES for August event. You may ride for one day, but the fee will remain the same.
- Please note the Rain Dates listed above - Visit our Website or Facebook for weather delays / postponements.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. A HELMET IS REQUIRED TO RIDE!!!! All riders must wear a DOT, SNELL, or other approved helmet, protective eyewear, and over the ankle foot wear.
2. GENERATORS allowed, but only QUIET 4 STROKE MODELS AFTER 10 P.M.
3. 10 MPH speed limit on camp grounds & farm yards.
4. The ATV Club is NOT responsible for accidents or thefts.
5. NO ALCOHOL is permitted during the ride and do not leave any litter on the trails.
6. You MUST STAY ON TRAILS and NO PASSING at any time.
7. Committee decisions are final.
8. Rules may be added/changed at the discretion of the ATV Club.
9. All attachments (plows etc.) MUST be removed
10. Above all, please use common sense and practice safety at all times.
11. Riders MUST BE 12 years of age w/parental supervision and must have a safety certificate as required by state law.
12. All riders under the age of 18 MUST have a parent's signature – * See registration form.

NOTE: There will be several groups for you to choose from – fast, medium, or slow. Our trails are privately owned and NOT state trails, so a state trail pass is NOT required. Most are heavily wooded with a single lane and have steep hill climbs and easy-outside trails.

These trails are truly unique, making the ride fun and challenging, even to the experienced rider.
