Tarka is a well-cared for popular example from the Shetland family.





This is a ready to go package with Mariner 15hp outboard, current boat safety certificate, comfortable and versatile accommodation, and the benefit of a trailer included.



The cabin consists of a forward V berth with infill to make a double bed, then storage lockers to port and starboard with sink and space for a stove for those essential cups of tea and coffee.

The cockpit is roomy for a boat of this size and provides comfortable seating and socialising.

Misty Blue





Misty Blue is a very sweet looking classic 1960's Seamaster 17 Cub. She benefits from a good quality, fairly recent hood, Mariner 15hp 4-stroke outboard and a current Boat Safety Certificate until April 2023.







In the cabin at the bow there is a V berth with infill and cushions, then midships there is a sink area to port and storage to starboard (there is space here for a porta potti).







Whilst Misty Blue is ready to go, I do describe her as a project, and that some work is required. The interior needs some fixing and tidying, for example loose cupboard doors and a roof panel needs refixing. The outboard runs very well and pumps water but I do not think that the fast idle level is connected as she is only starting on the choke, and not with any

extra revs. This is a good sign that she starts like this but particularly if the weather is cold then the fast idle would be needed to start her easily.

There are a number of extras on this boat such as auxiliary outboard bracket, 240 electric, auto bilge pump and she will provide the new owner with a sound base to develop and add value.

Misty Blue is £3,750

Izzy Whizzy

Izzy is a great example of the classic Freeman range and at 26ft offers spacious accommodation. With original gel coat and 'squall blue' anti slip decks Izzy looks very sharp and this is complemented by the new interior cushions.





There are no frills on this boat, she is pretty much as she would have been when she was built in 1974. The is a sea toilet, cooker (with grill and oven) and a sink with cold water. I like this straightforward simplicity and Izzy has the potential to be developed into whatever her new owners would like.
