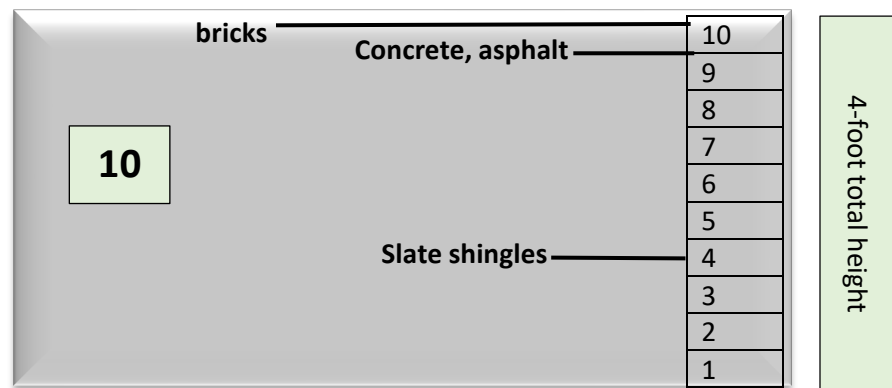


10 cubic-yard dumpster
Fill restrictions to follow 18-ton limit.

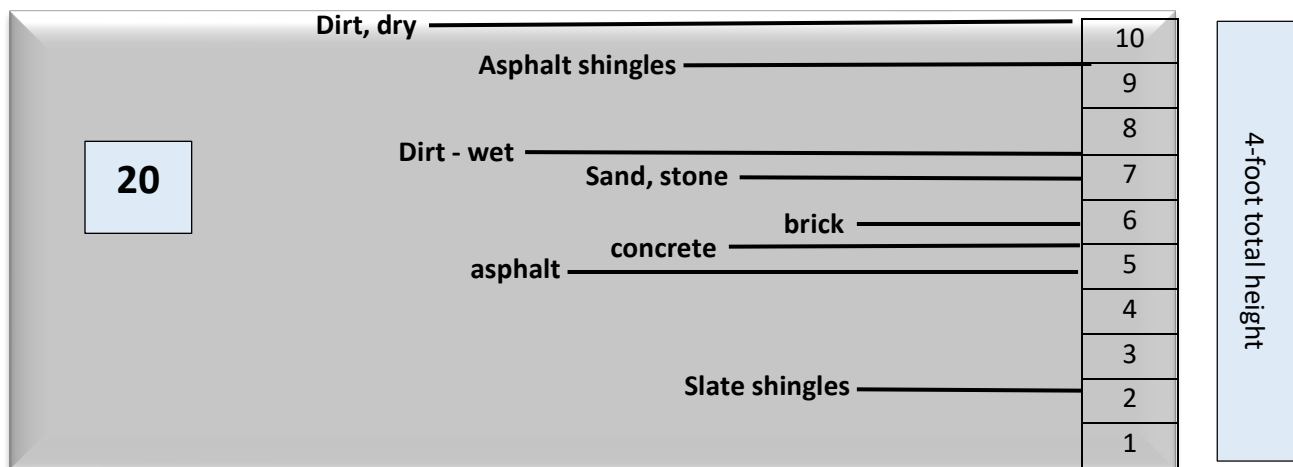


12-foot total length (and 6 feet wide total)
