2018 News & Views

A reminder to everyone that March is time for our membership meeting. As discussed last month in our newsletter, new updated Yellow Book Bylaws and Ground Rules will be distributed and a time will be set aside to discuss and go over the rules...this is a great opportunity to ask questions and get clarification on any rules that you might not fully understand.

A Committee will also be formed to begin seeking new people to serve on your board of directors beginning in January, 2019. Those board members whose terms will be up in December are Fred Richardson, Charlie Petrillo who has been serving the un-expired term of Morgan Flournoy and Bill Pearson who has been serving the un-expired term of Dennis Watermann. Please consider serving on that committee when volunteers are asked for. Everyone has a voice in selecting new board members to manage our park.

Also during our March meeting we will have a discussion concerning future lot sales and memberships rates for Texas Airstream Harbor and suggested fees for property transfers. An item of real concern...we are still getting what appears to be those strong wash & clean disposable rags with built in fibers into our sewer system that is picked up in our pumps which virtually shut down the sewer system. Please do not put those things down the toilets when finished...dispose of them in the trash. One rag will cause the pumps to be lifted up out of the sewer system which requires about three men working. Worse yet it could burn out a pump motor costing hundreds of dollars...Please do not put those down the toilets...
