International 64 at Lebanon was all about the fun. We missed you if you could not attend this year and hope to see you next year in Fryeburg, Maine- July 23-29, 2022. We had a great turn out at our Sunday breakfast buffet and our Tennessee Whiskey Tasting Happy Hour expanded to include martinis, margaritas, Old Fashions, and tequila shots. (We were over celebrating, I think, since we have not been together as a region for the last two years.) Therefore, Save the Date for Region 9 Rally: Let's Get Together April 26-May 1, 2002, in Mineola TX. Let me know your Rally Fun ideas and how you would like to help — Vendor? Flea Market? Happy Hour? Dutch Oven Potluck? Campfire? Finally, here are heads-up items that were approved at International. Unit leaders will address in more detail at rallies:

- An owner and each co-owner and his/her spouse/partner of a recreational vehicle
 manufactured by Airstream, Inc., upon becoming a Regular Member or Member at Large of the
 International Club, shall possess one vote per person for International Constitutional issues or
 International Officers (Each member will login to personal WBCCI account to cast individual
 vote.)
- With the election of International Officers being removed from the Delegates Meeting at the International Rally, it changes the purpose of a Delegates Meeting. The meeting will only consider and vote on Constitutional amendments, therefore the name of the meeting is changed to, Constitutional Delegates Meeting.
- Motion approved that establishes a new process for the recruitment of International Officers
 through a new Standing Committee, Nominations. The Committee will be composed of the
 principal stake holders in the search for candidates as well as membership representatives from
 the Regions of WBCCI and will operate year-round.
- Motion approved that establishes the right of any Member (Regular or Member at Large) to affiliate with any Local Club in WBCCI.
