
Fairs are paid on (Show your badge) for a boat ride on EITHER Swift Current/Josephine or on St. Mary Lake in the St. Mary area of the park. The Many Glacier ride consists of rides on the two lakes with a ¼ mile walk between the two. Many Glacier Hotel has a nice gift shop.

#### WATERTON - GLACIER INTERNATIONAL PEACE PARK

Glacier is, in our opinion one of the highlights of the trip and one of the world's beauty spot. If you are a slide photographer plan to take pictures and more pictures. The scenery is different at different times of the day and photographs differently.

First, stop at the St. Mary Visitor Center at the entrance, see the film program, and pick up a map. Plan to spend one day driving the entire road to Apgar (Going-to-the Sun Highway) on the west side and return; it is a 96 mile trip, and if you stop at the pull offs going and coming, which you should, it is an all day trip.

On another day stop at the Logan Pass information Center. There is an abundance of Bear Grass and other flowers on the side of the road opposite the parking lot. Walk to Hidden Lake from the Visitor Center or walk part way; a pleasant walk. There should be wild flowers, Ptarmigan nesting alone the trail and mountain goats. If you desire you may take a shorter, easier nature walk with a Park Naturalist from the Logan Pass Visitor Center.

The High Line Trail at Logan Pass on the side of the cliff may look spooky, but if the handrail is used, it is perfectly safe - providing you hold your breath, or your part mountain goat, and it isn't windy.

A two mile guided hike and boat ride to Grinnell Glacier leaves from the boat dock below the lodge at Swift Current Lake at XX;XX and xx;xx. This is the same boat trip without the hike, that is a kitty treat.

Sun Point Trail begins 2 miles west of Baring falls.

Baring Falls trail is very, very short.

Waterton Park is approximately 30 miles north of Babb on Route 6 in Canada. If you have as spare afternoon, it is worth the time. The red rock area is different, and the Prince of Wales Hotel serves a good, not too expensive lunch.
