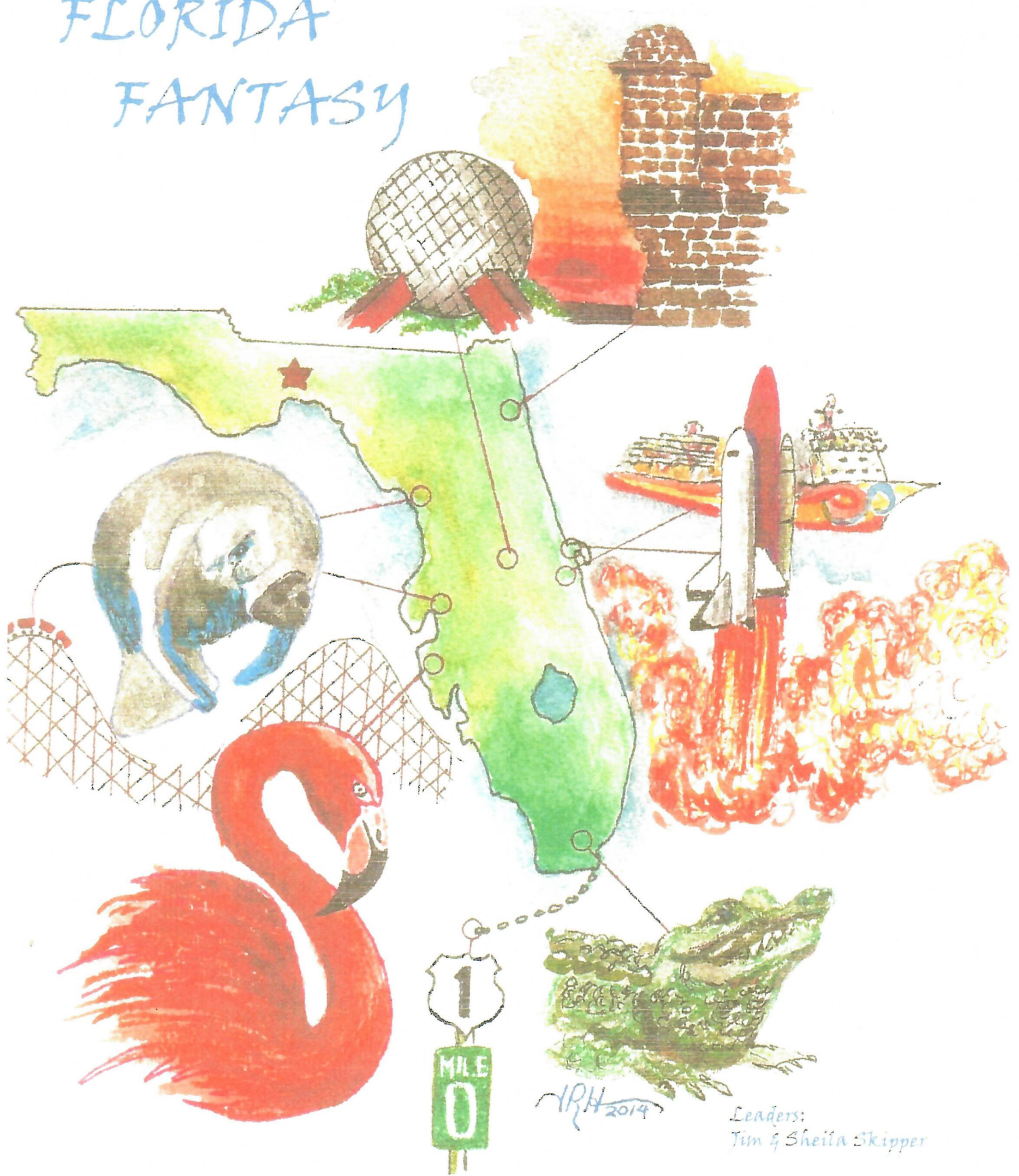

**Directions to North Florida Fairgrounds:** Departing St. John's Fairgrounds, turn left onto Florida 207 for 13.2 miles. Turn right onto US 17 toward Palatka for 2.7 miles. Turn left onto N 9<sup>th</sup> St. N 9<sup>th</sup> St. turns slightly right and becomes FL 20 W / Crill Ave. Follow FL 20 towards Interlachen/Hawthorne/Gainesville, FL. for approximately 42.7 miles. When you get to Gainesville turn left onto Highway 26 West for about three blocks. Turn right onto FL 24 for approx. 5-6 miles. Turn left onto FL 222. Travel West till Florida 20. (about 3-4 miles) FL 20 will merge with Highway 441. **(NOTE: Highway 441 will take you through Alachua, FL. There is an Airstream dealer, J.D. Sanders RV at 12380 NW US Highway 441. 386-462-3039).** Continue on Highway 441 toward High Springs, about 18 miles. Make a slight left onto US 27 N toward Ft. White and on to Perry, FL about 69.8 miles. **(NOTE: If you need a break: Turn left onto US 221 in Perry. There is a Walmart on the left- fuel gas and diesel).** In Perry, turn right onto US 19/US 27 North toward Tallahassee for 49 miles. At the intersection of US 27 and US 319 (Capitol Circle SE) turn left for 4.4 miles. Turn right onto County Road 259/Tram Road for 3 miles. Destination on right. Watch for parkers with red flags.
