### **TGCU Rally Host Duty Reminders**

- Coordinate plans together with rally host team; first couple listed is team leader.
- If an appointed team member is unable to participate, it is his responsibility to find a replacement & communicate that change to the host team leader at least two weeks prior to the event.
- Plan activities & meals for Thursday evening through Sunday morning.
- Send rally schedule to Debra, to post in newsletter (by 25th of month prior to rally, i.e. Mar. 25 for April 13-16 rally).
- Shop for food & decorating items needed, keeping receipts (reimbursable any time during the rally); check boxes in store room first for available décor—food & decorating budget for each rally is typically \$300 for 40-50 in attendance. [Saturday breakfast is pre-planned & not included in team responsibilities or expenses.]
- Check supplies on hand in clubhouse before ordering more. Decorate accordingly.
- Make coffee each morning; prepare and serve meals; remember to plan in advance to have propane turned on if oven is to be used.
- Post daily activities on clubhouse whiteboard.
- For each event, make sure kitchen is clean & restrooms supplied.
- Set up tables & chairs for meals, TGCU meeting & Sunday Devotional.
- Ask someone to lead in prayer before each meal.
- Make announcements & remind members of Sunday Service, informing them that our collections always go to the Zavalla Food Pantry.
- Clean up after each meal.
- Take trash to dumpster as needed.
- Turn off lights after each event **OR** arrange for those remaining later to do so.

Welcome to Summertime at Texas Airstream Harbor. It's not been too hot lately, but the humidity is real high which makes it very uncomfortable when outside working in the yard or around the park.





But our park residents have not let the weather stop them from landscaping and producing beautiful yards and flowers for all to enjoy...take a ride or walk around the

park and enjoy some of the beautiful scenery that our

members have put together.







Several members are traveling to the WBCCI-International Rally in

Rock Springs, Wyoming while others are planning trips across other states for vacations and visits. This

is a reminder that you hopefully have made plans to have someone care for your yards while "on the road" and have emergency access with someone just in case. For yard maintenance you can contact Jerry Boulware at 936-465-1597 or Hayden Clowers at 936-707-0671.



We have had several Work Days in the past few weeks, repairing a lot of potholes in our streets, cleaning up around our old sewer plant and also the new one. Crews got together, too to clean up around the water well near the Lauderdales & Davis's place and recently cleaning up around the burn pile.







There is no rally scheduled for the June, July and August. During our last meeting the membership and board voted to move forward with putting Water Well number three on line with the TCEQ. Several Items need to be completed as we make application for its addition to our Public Water System.

THE YELLOW ROSE

A water meter has been installed so that we can pump water and catch raw water samples to submit to our laboratory to check it for any contaminants and also so that we can test the amount of water that the well will produce in a 36 hour test. Carl Pennington will be turning the well on and catching the samples and conducting the tests. Other members have been researching legal descriptions of adjoining properties for required easements. Bids have been received for installing a security fence around the well and its controller. Plans are to remove the old Pressure tank and old Water tank as they will not be used in the well production if approved.

Surveyors have been out reviewing our easement lines for our effluent for the wastewater plant line and also for our water line that crosses Corps property from our water plant to our distribution lines in the park. Once those surveys are complete and placed in the required documents for the Corps we should be at a point to complete that project.
