



> Continue North on Hwy. 281 and enter into Canada at the Peace Gardens. (Hwy. 281 becomes Hwy.10 in Canada.)

Turn Left onto 2nd Avenue NORTHWEST, and continue to the Tourist Park. (Vermilion Park)






Everyone else started honking too, so I leaned out my window and waved and smiled all of those loving people.
