Turn Right (East) on Transcanada 1 to Hwy.10, than turn left on Hwy.10.

There is a large rest area about 29 mi. North of Brandon, at the intersection of the Yellow Head Hwy and Hwy.10. Continue on Hwy.10 .

Continuing North on Hwy.10 through Riding Mountain National Park.(Watch for moose, deer, possibly bear along this scenic drive through the park.)

After leaving the park, continue North on Hwy.10 until joined by Hwy. 5.

Continue North on Hwy. 5A/10A into Dauphin to 2nd Avenue **NORTHWEST.**

Turn Left onto **2nd Avenue NORTHWEST,** and continue to the Tourist Park. (Vermilion Park)
