



Derby Pie was created by George Kerns with the help of his parents for a restaurant in Prospect, Ky. known as the Melrose Inn. Many hours were spent trying to find the unique blend of flavors that make up this classic dessert. You will recognize the chocolate chips and walnuts, but no one has ever been able to duplicate the special filling and delicate crust. The pies are still made to this day by the Kerns family in a relative small plant here in Louisville. The grandchildren of the originator are carrying on the tradition of this unique and delicious pie.



Suggestions for Afternoon

There are several antiques shops on Broadway as well as a good coffee shop, bookstore and a wonderful Kentucky Store next to the coffee shop. There are several nice little restaurants in the downtown, some on Broadway and some on the walking Mall around the corner.

The men may enjoy checking out the Military Museum, just about 1 block from the History Center. Very good Museum. Also a small new Museum on corner by parking lot for the City of Frankfort.

There is a nice bakery as well as Melanies and Marshall's restaurants on Main Street just one block up from Broadway.

Restaurants recommended to us were Gibby's, Kentucky Coffee Tree Cafe, Nema's and Serafini.

If you need to do some shopping there are a wide variety of shops including Walmart and K Mart out on Rt. 127 near the I 64 Interstate. There are a number of restaurants out that way also. This is a large commercial area.

The Kentucky Viet Nam Memorial:

The Memorial was opened on November 11, 1988. It honors the 125,000 Kentuckians who served this nation so courageously during the Vietnam War. Each name is precisely located so that the shadow of the gnomon (pronounced "noman") touches his name on the anniversary of his death. Thus, each individual is honored with a personal tribute. The names of Kentuckians listed as missing in action are etched in front of the gnomon where the shadow never falls, paying special tribute to their personal sacrifice and signifying our continued vigil until they are returned. When their names are identified and they are officially declared casualty, their names are etched on the plaza and removed from the granite in front of the gnomon. The Kentucky Memorial is one of the largest granite memorials in the nation and contains 327 cut stone panels weighing more than 215 tons.


If you would like to go downtown – follow the directions for Keeneland as you leave the campground but stay on Georgetown Rd. This will run into Newton Pike (25 South) at light go left. It is approximately 6.5 miles from the campground to downtown area. Most of the stores are on Main Street. There are a few restaurants downtown.

There is a very large shopping area called "Hamburg Pavillion"—from downtown take Midland Ave. this runs into Winchester Rd. follow Winchester (cross 4 New Circle Road and keep going) turn right on Sir Barton Way (just before you get to I 75) this area is loaded with stores for men and women and many restaurants. You can also reach this easily from the campground by taking I 75 to exit 108 and there you are. It is such a large area you cannot miss it.

There are many interesting things to see in Lexington and the surrounding area. The quaint town of Midway is delightful. There are interesting shops and a couple nice little restaurants. Check your book on Lexington and you will find more things than you could possibly do in one day. Some may decide to go back into the Horse Park. There are a number of Historical Homes in Lexington that are open to the public.

There is another very nice Shopping Mall called "The Mall at Lexington Green." This one is known for their wonderful bookstore call Joseph-Beth; there are several good restaurants in the mall as well as the usual stores. It is also on your map. Just off of New Circle Road on Nicholasville Rd.

Campground to Country Cottage Gifts & Decorating:

Turn left and then almost immediately you'll turn right onto Broadway. Stay on Broadway for approximately 1/4 mile. Dairy Queen is on the right. From the DQ, you'll reverse steps back to Paintsville Lake/Campground.
